

In the Name of God Amen, the twenty eight day of April in
 the year of our Lord God 1757 Robert Johnson of North Carolina
 in the County of Rowan, being very sick & weak in Body, but of
 perfect Mind & Memory Thanks be given unto God therefore
 calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing that
 it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & ordain this
 my last Will & Testament; that is to say, principally & first
 of all I give & recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that
 gave it: & for my Body I recommend it to the Earth to be bur-
 ied in a Christian like & decent Manner, at the Discretion of
 my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection,
 I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, &
 as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God
 to bless me in this Life, I give bequeath & dispose of the
 same in the following Manner & Form. I ordain my funeral
 charges to be paid of the whole of my Estate: I also ordain what
 Debts is due to me to be paid so far as they will reach
 of Debts which I justly owe and if any remains unpaid
 they shall be paid off the whole of my Estate. Inheritance I give
 and bequeath to Lilly my dearly beloved Wife during her
 natural Life one third part of my Land with all the Char-
 tyers & Improvements. Also one third part of all the mov-
 ables with the Use of one gray Mare. Also I give my well be-
 loved Sons (viz) John Thomas & Robert all my Land equally
 to be divided amongst them & Robert shall have all the
 Plantation or other ground with the Improvements after his
 Mother's Decease, in his part of the Land. Also Robert shall
 have one bay Saddle. Also I give John all my Cloys & Sadel
 with one gray Saddle. Also I give Thomas one black mare &
 Saddle to be paid for of the whole Estate. Also I give my
 well beloved Daughter Margaret one Mare & Saddle to be paid
 for of the whole of my Estate. & when she goes for her self
 she shall have an equal share of the Stock & movables

that is one her Mother's Trade. I ordain that the four youngest Chil-
 dren (viz) Robert Sarah Mary & Phoeby shall be schooled & maintained,
 in small Dutch washing & Laoging with so pecious Cloths at the
 publick Charge of all the Family. I also order that Sarah Mary and
Phoeby shall have an equal share of the Stock as they arise at any
 or goes to so for themselves with my little Trade to be equally divided
 amongst the three (viz) my Wives Childs of the movables at her
 Decease. I also order that all the Increase of all the above mentioned
 Mans be equally divided amongst the whole Family. I also con-
 stitute make & ordain my well beloved Wife Lilly & John McConnell
 Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof
