Bed clothes and if she chuse to remain with my son
Andrew to have a good maintenance off my Estate
or part thereof bequeathed to him the said Andrew
& a decent Burial if she remains with him until
the end of her time in this world. Then I give and
bequeath to my Son William Esq; of Priddy
James two fowounds and a thick cloth white hat
Then I give and bequeath my Son William two
Pounds

Item I give & bequeath to my Son John Ten pounds
Item I give & bequeath my Daughter Elizabeth Hutton
Ten pounds — Item I give and bequeath to my grand
Daughter Margaret Hutton Two pounds. Item
I give and bequeath to my Son Robert One Negro
Wench named Millie. Item I give and bequeath
to my Son Andrew the Plantation I now live on
with One hundred Acres adjoining thereto taken
by a deed from the States office, to him his Heirs
and Assigns for ever, and all way of the appur-
tenances thereto belonging or appertaining, &
One Negro boy named Caesar, and if any part or
Parcel of my Estate or remaining after the paya-
ment of all and way of the former legacies &
Bequeathments yet remaining it is to be equally
divided between my Son Robert and my Son
Andrew, likewise I constitute and Ordain
James Willson & Robert Ramsey my trusty
friends to be my whole and sole Executors of
this my last Will and Testament —
