1768 In the Name of God Amen This eighteenth Day of November
in the year of Robert McQuiston of the Province of North Carolina
in County of Rowan being informed by Body, but of
sound memory & judgment do make & publish this my last
Will & Testament whither by word or writing if such be maid
by me First I bequeath my soul to God walking through grace
in Christ my Saviour for that merit promised to them of
believing him and my Body to be interred as my Executors shall
think fit. First of all to pay my just Debts & to divide my
Estate as followeth to wit. First of all I give to my Dearly
beloved Wife. Ann McQuiston & and my Son Walter McQuiston
all my Estate Debts and reasonable equity to be divided between
them except what I shall hereafter bequeath to the Rest of
my children with my Plantation and all the perticulars there-
unto belonging during her life time or widowhood then to my
Son Walter McQuiston if marie again I allow her but twenty
Pounds and her Riding & Bed of Cloas with a Chair & stool
and her Part of the Money to her to dispose as she shall think fit
and my warning release to divide them as she thinks fit. Secondly
I give my Son James McQuiston my only son and

is, I bequeath his Son Robert McQuiston Thirdly I give to John
Fridell or my Daughter Margery one Guine to be given to my gran-
daughter Ann. Fourthly I give to my Son John McQuiston fifty Pounds to be
paid out of the first Guine due of my Plantation of Roward. Fifthly I give
to my Daughter Jean McQuiston married to James Thirly twenty Pounds
to be paid out of the two first Guines now by William Godfray.
Sixtly I give to my Daughter Catharina McQuiston & Mary McQuiston each
of them thirty Pounds a piece out of the two last Guines of my Plantation
& black man & child of said Maine Fridell and a set to be given and
whoever gets the black man is to get three Pounds and thair Rides
& Cloas to their Mothers Pleasure Lastly I make my Will and my
Son Walter Executors of this my last Will & Testament and That this
testimony given signed sealed published & declared in the presence
of us.

In the Name of God Amen I James McQuistock of the County
of Rowan in the Province of North Carolina being made a
but of sound memory (before God) Do make & publish this my last
Will & Testament in manner following. That is to say Item First I
give & bequeath to my Dearly beloved wife Mary McQuistock the sum
of all my Goods & Chattels & the third of the Plantation on which I live
in Maintenance while she lives or while she remains a widow or
cause to live on 2 places. Also I give all the Plantation on which she
lives to my Son Samuel McQuistock it being situated on & west of George
Davidson senior land consisting of three hundred & eighty six acres
of Land to him & his Heirs forever. I give to my Son William Mc-
Quistock three hundred acres of land situated on & west of the Plantation
on which I live & the rest of his brother old McQuistock
