 two thirds to be equally divided between my aforesaid
 Children viz *Robt. Jnr. Mary & Margret Baker*. *Wm.*
 always that my purpose & Intent is that the Remain-
 der third aforesaid may continue in the Hands of my
 Wife till said Children come of age: & at each of
 coming to age to receive only their equal Dividend
 as I am now possessed of at my Death. But in case
 that them or any of the above Children should die
 before the come of age his or their part is to be equ-
 ally divided amongst the surviving heirs. And lastly I do
 hereby ordain my said Wife *Eliza Baker* her suc-
 cessors & assigns my last Will & Testament in Trust
 & purpose in my will contained, and I make
 my friend *Hugh Lawson* Executor of this my will to
 see the same performed according to my true
 & meaning. In witness whereof I the said
 to this my last Will & Testament set my hand
 on the fourth Day of December in the year 1757.

 Whereas *I Amos Edwards* of New Jersey in former Years
 North Carolina, being far advanced in Years & well knowing the uncer-
 tainty of Life & the certainty of Death; at one Time or other, to those you
 have bequeathed me the following Lands, as my last Will and Testament,
 that is to say principally and first of all, I recommended my Soul and
 the Soul & my Body to the Earth to be interred in a Christian like decent
 manner at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named; and
 as touching such worldly Substances wherewith I am possessed of,
 I have bequeathed & disposed of the same in the following manner & Form
 I advise and it is my Will that all my just Debts & Charges of funeral
 Charges be paid & satisfied by my Executors. *Wm.* I give to my eldest
 son *David Edwards* one hundred & fifty Acres of Land on the south
 side of the *W. River* I live on to him & his Heirs forever, with paying
 equal quantity of Charges of getting Deed. *Wm.* I give to my son
Josua Edwards one hundred & fifty Acres of Land including the
 place he formerly lived on & the dividing to be between him and
 Brother *Wm.* is a black oak already marked, it to him and
 his Heirs forever, with paying equal quantity of Charges to
 the Quantity of Land for Deed. *Wm.* I give to my son *Isaac*
Edwards three hundred & fifty Acres of Land including the place
 he now live on, it for the Use of my Wife and Family during
 her Life & after her Death, it for him & his Heirs forever.
 I have bequeathed to my Wife *Elizabet Edwards* during her natural Life
 one Acre of all kinds of Cattle Sheep Horses & Hogs for her use & the
 also the House hold Goods, & after her Death to be equally divided
 my son *Isaac Edwards* and my Daughters *Elizabet Brown* *Martha*
Norris, *Elizabet Martha & Isaac Edwards* to them & their Heirs
 And it is my Will & Desire that each & every of them take of my
 Daughter *Martha*. I also leave to my Wife my working Tools
 & Provision during her Life, and after her Death to my son
Edwards to him & his Heirs forever. I appoint & name
 my two Sons *Josua & Isaac Edwards* whole & sole Executors
