& my body to be decently buried; Secondly I give & bequeath  
unto my well beloved wife Ann her part of the house & all  
her household, which she now possesses, & my round mare,  
two cows, & her victuals & washing. Thirdly unto my son  
Samuel I also give & bequeath all the land that I possess  
in N<sup>c</sup>. Carolina & my year old colt & all ~~with~~ my plantation  
tools & the remainder of my horned cattle & all my hogs, my  
waggon I leave betwixt my sons Robert & Samuel. If my  
round mare should have a colt next spring I give it to  
my granddaughter Peggy & I do hereby further more consti-  
tute & appoint my youngest son Samuel to be executor  
of this my last will & test: & I do hereby make & appoint  
this & no other as my real & last will & test: In witness  
whereof I have hereunto set my hand & affixed my seal  
this 31<sup>st</sup> Day of May A<sup>D</sup> 1799.

A<sup>D</sup> 1781 I Thomas Lyall of Rowan County in the State  
of N<sup>c</sup>. Carolina being sick & weak in body but of perfect  
mind & memory, thanks be given to God, & calling to mind  
my mortality & that it is appointed to man to die, do make  
this my last will & test: & principally & first of all I recommend  
my soul into the hands of God who gave it hoping through the  
merits, death & passion of my Lord & Saviour Jesus Christ, to  
have a full & free pardon of all my sins, & to inherit everlasting  
life. And my body I commit to the earth to be buried in a decent  
& christian burial at the discretion of my executors hereafter named  
nothing doubting but to receive the same again at the general  
resurrection by the mighty power of God. And as touching such  
worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me in this  
life. I give demise, bequeath & dispose of in the following  
manner & form (Viz.) I will that all those just debts & duties  
as I do owe either in right or conscience be paid as soon as may be  
after my decease by my executors hereafter named.

Item I give & bequeath unto my loving wife Mary one third  
part of all & singular my estate both real & personal, during  
the term of her natural life & at her death the third part aforesaid  
to descend to my children to be equally divided amongst them &  
share alike & to their heirs & assigns forever.

Item I give & bequeath & demise to my loving daughter Margaret  
my plantation on the south fork of the Garden River, which  
I bought of Abner Thomson, & one part of my personal estate  
to her & her heirs & assigns forever.
