joining Land & Improvements (accepting & reserving throughout unto
my loving Wife Jane Miller the full Knowledge of the Building House
together with a comfortable Maintenance during the Term of her Natural
Life to hold to her & her Heirs & Assigns forever. Fourthly. I give and
bequeath unto my beloved Son Thomas Miller, the sum of forty Shillings
proclamation Money. And unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth Cooper
the sum of twenty Shillings proclamation money. I also bequeath
unto my Grandson Samuel Miller twenty Pounds proclamation
Money. And unto my Grandson Samuel Cooper one hund.
to my Grandson Thomas Cooper one hund. all which Bequeathments
I allow to be lived out of my moveable Estate. Fifthly. I give myself
and bequeath unto my beloved Son Samuel Miller all that Tract
of Land which I bought from Robert Luckie containing 686 Acres
on which my son in law Samuel Cooper now dwells, provided how-
ever that if the said Samuel Cooper shall within the space of two
