1462 In the name of God Amen I Samuel Shinn of County of New York being very sick & weak in Body but of perfect Mind and Memory Charles be given unto God: Calling unto mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die Do make & declare this my last Will & Testament that in to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the Hand of Almighty God that give it and my Body I recommend to the Earth to be buried in decent & Christian Buriall at the Discretion of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty Power of God. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me in this Life I give & dispose of the same in the following Manner & Form. First I give & bequeath to my dearly beloved Wife Abigail one third Part of all my Estate both real & personal. Also I give to my well beloved Son Thomas the sum of

Also I give to my well beloved Son John two hundred & fifty Shillings of my dead's Land including the Improvement that Richard Lewis now lives upon together with two black mares one of which is a natural pacer. Also I give to my Daughter Leah Cozine two Cows one flater Red and aden saddle. Also I give to my three youngest Daughters Rachel Sarah & Hannah the sum of fifteen Shillings apiece to be lived as aforesaid. Also I give to my Son Benjamin the remaining Part of that Tract of Land I sold to my Son Elias. Also I give to my two Sons Luc & Joseph the Plantation I now live upon with each of them the Mear that they now share. And I do hereby utterly Revoke & Revoke, & every other former Testament Will & any Request & Request by me in any Ways before named made or bequeathed: ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will and Testament and I do constitute & appoint my Wife Abigail to be sole & sole Executrix. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this twentieth of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and fifty one.
