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To me is to be equally divided as aforesaid, my wife is to have & child's part with the children out of the stock & household goods besides what is willed to her.

I will that John Hendricks have that hundred acres of land that I bought of George March & also what land he agreed with me for out of my tract, & eighty pounds which he is to pay for it to be divided between my wife & children equally. I do hereby constitute & appoint my well beloved friends Jacob Crows & Jacob Boos my executors of this my last will & test: And I do hereby disannul & make void all other wills & bequeaths by me made or done, ratifying & allowing this & no other to be my last will & testament In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 17th of July 1787.

I Samuel Wilson of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina being sick & weak in body but perfect in mind & memory & calling to mind the mortality of my body knowing it is appointed for all men once to die I make this my last will & testament, principally I give my soul to God & my body to be buried in a decent Christian manner, & as touching such worldly estate I give & devise & dispose of in following manner & to wit.

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First of all it is my desire that those just debts and duties, as I owe to any manner of persons whether in right or conscience be well & truly paid & satisfied in some convenient time after my decease by my executors hereafter named:

I give & bequeath to my dearly beloved wife children William, John & Samuel Wilson, Jane Kin & Sarah Robinson the sum of five pounds current money of the State to each of them.

I give & bequeath & devise unto my loving son George Wilson my plantation whereon I now live with all the benefits & improvements thereunto belonging, with all the rest of my estate real & personal, whole & sole to his use after my decease I allow all my clothing to be given to my son Samuel. Lastly I name & ordain & constitute & appoint my well beloved son William & Samuel Wilson to be the whole & sole executors of this my last will & test: hereby revoking & annulling off former wills & testaments, bequeaths, devises legacies & executors by me in any manner & ways before named, willed, bequeathed, devised or appointed, ratifying this & no other to be my last will & testament Signed, sealed published & pronounced.
& declared in the presence of us.
