And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all & every former test: with legacies, bequests & executory by me in any wise before named, willed & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this twenty second day of September in the year of our Lord 1800.

In the name of God Amen. I Sarah ^{Brady} ~~Brady~~ of Rowan County & State of N^c Carolina being of perfect mind & memory (blessed be God therefore, do this 27th day of October in the year of our Lord 1800. make & publish this my last will & testament in manner & form following, that is to say I hereby I recommend my soul into the hands of allmighty God who gave it me; and my body to the earth from whence it came, in hopes of a joyful resurrection through the merits of my Saviour Jesus Christ.

And as for the worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me I dispose of as follows.

First I give & bequeath to my daughter Anne my feather bed & to her daughter Polly my large looking glass.

Item. I give to my daughter Sarah, one of my Burdai Table Cloaths.

I give to my daughter Mary my large Plater Dish and my will is that my plater plates be equally divided between my two daughters Sarah & Mary.

It. I give to my son James my large Bible & psalm book with my walnut-table, Iron pot & large Dutch Oven also my small looking glass. Churn Milk Crocks & pans & to his wife Ruth my new Cloath Cloak.

It. I give to my daughter Peggys Daughter Sally my earthen plates.

It. I give to my son Johns Daughter Sally my silver Buttons & my other Burdai Table Cloath.

It. I give to my son Hugers Daughter Sally Cornuth my large Decanter & small trunk.

And also it is my will that my under or chaff bed with all my bed furniture be valued by two or more indifferent persons and to be taken by some of my children at the prouement as so much of their part of my salable estate. And it is further my will that the residue of my books and also the residue of my table & shelf furniture be divided by my executors as equal as may be amongst all my children & also my Iron stand.

It is my will that my wearing apparel be divided amongst all my daughters at their own discretion.

My will also is that my shirting yarn be woven and the cloth sold & after the weaving is paid the remainder of the money or so much of it as will be necessary I direct my son Hugh to purchase with it for my negro woman Doll Callus for a gown a good wool hat & mullein for an apron with a pair of good shoes - & the remainder of the money if any there to pay funerals & other charges.

It is further my will that all my property of every kind not heretofore mentioned or bequeathed with my negro wench Doll be sold at public vendue by my executors & the value thereof to be divided equally amongst all my children - or their heirs.

And my will is that my said wench Doll have liberty to make choice amongst all my children before sold which of them she would desire to live with, & then if able to purchase her.

It is also my will that said wench Doll live where she now doeth until the vendue.

And I hereby make & ordain my sons Walter & Hugh Braly executors of this my last will & testament. In witness whereof I the said Sarah Braly have to this my last will & test: set my hand & seal the day & year above mentioned.
