In the name of God Amen! I Salomon Jones of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina, being sick & weak in body but of sound & perfect sense & memory thanks be to God for the same, calling to mind the mortality of my body, & knowing it is appointed for all men once to die, do make constitute & ordain, this my last will & test: in manner & form following. Principally I recommend my soul to God that gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian like manner, at the discretion of my friends that survive me; and as touching such worldly estate as it has pleased God to bless me with, I give, devise, & dispose of the same in following manner.

I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth one bed & furniture, one wheel, one cow, one saddle, one roost mare. Then I give unto my daughter Rebecca Jones twenty five pounds current money.

Then I give & bequeath unto my daughter Ruth Long twenty five pounds current money.

Then I give & bequeath unto my daughter Nancy Long twenty five pounds in current money.

Then I give & bequeath unto my daughter Margaret Jones twenty five pounds current money.

My will & desire is that the land & plantation, whereon I now live should remain in the possession, of my beloved wife until her decease then to be sold at the discretion of my executors & equally divided between my children.

My will & desire is that my other tract of land, lying on Howards branch, on the waters of Dutchmanns creek, containing three hundred acres, should be rented out annually for five years from the date of this my last will & test: & the money it fetches to be equally divided among all my children, & at the expiration of five years as above mentioned said land to be sold & equally divided among all my children. My will & desire is that all my moveable property which I have not willed to my beloved wife, should be sold by public sale, at the discretion of my executors, & after all my just debts are paid, to be distributed, to make up each ones portion as aforementioned, the remainder to be equally divided between my beloved wife & all my children & their heirs forever.

Lastly I nominate & appoint my beloved wife Elizabeth Jones Nathan Wallis, & Peter Glascock executors of this my last will & test: hereby revoking all former wills & test: by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal this 1st day of March 1804.
