as the act of Assembly directs respecting intestate Estates. And last-
ly I do hereby constitute & appoint my brother William Nobis
and my brother in law John Cather Executors in trust of this

to com to ^{the} ment. I do on this first day of November in the year of our Lord 1791 pub-
lish this my last will and testament first of all I give my soul to God through our Lord
Jesus Christ & my body to be decently buried upon the earth in a christian like
manner at the discretion of my Executors hoping to have them again united together
at the great & general Resurrection by the mighty power of God & as touching
worldly goods as it pleas Almighty God to bless me with in this life I do devise
& dispose of in this manner that is to say first I give unto my beloved wife
Mary Nolan 7 1/2 acres of Land to be lade of where I now live including the
dwelling & plantation as far as the main branch between the & the old place
to her & her heirs & assigns forever and also I give to her my several more
years & a black mare & eight head of sheep & all my hogs & all my crop &
beds & furniture to her & her heirs for ever 2 I give & bequeath to my son
Stephen Nolan my several colts & my youngest bundle huffer taken
his heirs forever. 3 I give & bequeath to my son Piston Nolan my
saddle & the black colt he paying to my son Isaac Nolan one half there-
of & a colt which colt to be valued by two men at three years old
4 I give & bequeath to my granddaughter Ann Kolderfeld & on her decease
to be delivered my daughter Hanne Kolderfeld for the use of the child
immediately after my decease. 5 I give & bequeath to my wife Mary
Nolan all the rest of my stocks of cattle to her use she giving to my
son Linto Nolan James Albia Mary & Eleanor Moland a cash huffer
with my children grow up & also I give to my wife as above
with all the rest of my household furniture of every kind & name

 West 77 Ch. and 75 Links past along Woodruffs
 line to the beginning, containing 82 Acres to the same
 more or less, I also devise and bequeath unto the
 said Mr. Samuel McCobb my Negro fellow which
 that went of with the British Troops in case he can
 be ever recovered
