In the name of God amen I Henry Ricker - of Rowan County in the State of N^t Carolina being very sick in body but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God for it, Do this 13th Day of November in the year of our Lord 1793. Make & publish this my last will & testament, in manner following that is to say.

It is my will that my well beloved wife Catharine Ricker shall keep her profession on the plantation I now live on together with all my beloved children as like in my life time as long as she shall be a widow after her death or if she should marry again then it is my will that my well beloved son Henry Ricker shall possess the land I now live on after he shall take his rights of the land, & live on, in a twelve month after he shall pay to each of his sisters ten pound good & lawfull money but if my son Henry should die before he should have her profession of the plantation, which he shall not have before his twenty one years of age, it is my will that the plantation shall be sold after my wife death & equal divided amongst my children, it is my will that all my wife, & my children that will obey her & stay with her do make of the plantation shall be equally divided amongst them, any stock they rise during the time, they live possible together on the plantation shall be equal divided amongst them - Concerning all other property to me belonging it is my will that the three oldest daughters shall each of them have when they marry as before it convenient a bed and

one cow each and the balance left it is my will it shall be equal divided amongst the rest of my children - Now I desire that this my last will & testament be faithfully fulfilled - in witness whereof I the said Henry Ricker have set my hand & seal the Day & year above written.

I Stephen Roberts of the County of Rowan & State of N^t Carolina being weak in body but of sound mind & memory do make this my last will & test: Viz First I give my soul to God that gave it to my body to the dust to be buried in a decent manner at the direction of my executors And as to what worldly property it hat pleased God to bless me it is my will that it be disposed of in the following manner.

Viz On the first place it is my will that all my just debt be paid

I give to my beloved wife Phoebe all my Negroes stock of every kind, plantation tools, household furniture too us use during her natural life the Negro to put in her profession as soon as the crop is made where they are now under the direction of my son Warren.

I give & devise to my son Warren Roberts the tract of land containing thirty one acres & one half wherein I now live & also one hundred acres of land where my mill stands on Polli creek also 200 acres of land I purchased of William Moore to him & his heirs forever also the profits arising from my negroes stock & household & furniture which will be more than will maintain my wife after my death I give & devise to my son Joseph Roberts one tract of land purchased of Thomas Carson known by the name of Millers place also one tract of land containing 60 acres I purchased of John Ford to him & his heirs forever.

It is my will that my plantation on Country line creek in the County of Caswell be sold & the money arising therefrom together with all the residue of my estate to be equally divided between my son Warren Roberts & Joseph Roberts, my daughter Polly Harrell, Molly Morton, Judith Eymond & Phoebe Richmond Nancy Roberts & Betsy Roberts, daughter of my son William Roberts jointly to be considered to have a share provided that it shall be considered that Judith Eymond has received ninety pounds Virginia money already paid for the performance of the above my last will & test. I do appoint my beloved wife Phoebe Roberts my son Warren Roberts & my true friend John Wilson executors of this last will & test. as witness I have hereunto set my hand & seal q. of July 1802.

I Deborah Biles of the State of North Carolina of Rowan County being in perfect health of Body & of perfect mind & memory Thanks be given unto God I calling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all women to die I make & ordain this my last will & testament; That is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul into the hands of almighty God that gave it and my body I recommend to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors: nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God. And as touching such worldly Estate where with it had pleased god to bless me in this life I give, devise, & dispose of the same in following manner & form. — First I give & bequeath to Elizabeth Rose & Abby Biles all my real & personal property what soever from & their heirs for ever after my death to be equally divided between the two sisters at the direction of my executors. I do hereby constitute make & ordain & appoint my dear beloved friend James Rose & my dear beloved sister Ann Biles as my executors of this my last will & testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul every other former testament, will, legacies, bequeaths & covenants by me in any wise before named, willed & bequeathed — ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last will & test: in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
