Residue of what God has blessed me with to be disposed of in
the same following - FIRST I give and Bequeath to my
true and loving Wife Martha Moore, the Bay Mare &
her Saddle and her Bed and furniture thence belonging,
over and above her right of dower and my Land
in Kent State to Equally divided between my four
Sons William Robert, Benjamin, and Josiah upon their
giving to each of their Sisters Mary, Elizabeth & Martha
a Cow and Calf when they Arrive to the ag. of Sixteen
Years old, and the personal Estate, except the above
Bequests to be equally divided between my three
Daughters Mary, Elizabeth and Martha, and I do
apparell constitute and appoint Martha Moore my
true and loving Wife and Joseph Cunningham my
Trusty and well beloved Brother to execute this my
Will, In witness whereof I do publicly pronounce
and declare this and no other to be my last Will
and Testament, In witness whereof I have caused
to set my hand and affest my seal this 1st day
of Sept: One thousand seven hundred & Ninety Nine

(119) This being my last will and Testament
being Weak of Body but of Perfect Memory
FIRST of all I bequeath to my beloved wife Martha
Allison the third part of my whole Estate, all household
furniture, Likewise a young Bay Mare free, Also
a Negro by name Peter, during his Widethood, afterward
to be sold and equally divided among the Children
also to my two Sons Richard and Thomas Allison
all my lands to be divided Equally between them the
Ented Land to be staked out of the Stock, to my
two Daughters I bequeath that is to Naomi and
Ann Allison 1500 pounds each, the Negro Wench
and her Children, Likewise the Stock to be sold by
Public Vendue and divided equally among the
Children, These particulars I pronounced to be
my last Will before these Witnesses this 12th
day of February in the Year of our Lord 1790
