To my daughter Anne I bequeath my negro girl Minda her bed & furniture, horse & saddle, chest, & one fourth part of my cows & sheep & books.

To my daughter Mary I give & desire her bed & furniture horse & saddle & chest & one fourth of my cows, sheep & books.

To my daughter Elizabeth I give & bequeath her bed & furniture, horse & saddle, chest & one fourth of my cattle & sheep & my books.

My will & desire further is that my sons Samuel John, & James three years after my death do each of them pay to my grandson William Bowman Son of Samuel Bowman ten pounds out of the land bequeathed to them in Cumberland settlements on the western waters, which money I desire to be put to interest until he arrives of age of twenty one years and if he should die before this time to be equally divided between my surviving daughters further I wish & desire that my waggon & gears, my clock & smith tools be sold to pay my debts.

Lastly I do nominate constitute & appoint my loving wife Elizabeth Bowman my son Samuel Brown & son Joseph Bowman my executors of this my last will & testament & I do utterly revoke & disannul all former will or wills by me made & executors by me appointed, ratifying & confirming this & this

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only as my last will & testament.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Thomas Barr forty shillings

Item I give & bequeath unto my grand son John Barr son of Damus Barr thirty pounds.

Item I give & bequeath unto my son Damus Barr the plantation or tract of land whereon I now live & all the residue of my moveable estate to be equally divided between my wife Catharine & my son Damus Barr

Lastly I do hereby nominate constitute & appoint my loving wife Catharine Barr & my son Damus Barr executor of this my last will & test. & I do hereby utterly revoke & disavow all & every other wills by me made or executed by me in any wise appointed, ratifying & confirming this only to be my last will & test. To my Brother Hugh Barr I give & bequeath a free & exclusive right & title to one third of the land under my name on Broad river, also to one third of the land I live upon likewise a title to one half of the other land here under my name acknowledging him already possessed of one half of the moveable effects though the division has not yet taken place.

To my Brother Patrick Barr I give & bequeath a free & exclusive right & title to one third of the land on Broad river under my name

And if it should so happen that my son should die a minor, I give & bequeath his estate to be divided as follow viz one fifth among my three sisters Sarah, Mary & Catharine. And after fifth pounds to my brother Hugh the remainder be divided in four equal parts among my three brothers Hugh, John & Patrick & my nephew William Barr son of Damus Barr deceased. And I do hereby appoint & ordain my three brothers Hugh, John & Patrick Barr to be my executors of this my last will & test: In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand & seal, the day & year above written
