Quonack* Thomas *W. Quonack* Land & the bounds to take out a Road for it, also a Tract of Land in the County of *Andover* near twelve mile Creek as *W. D.* hath more at large appear & what Stock he has already received to him his Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give and bequeath unto my beloved Son John one half of the Tract of Land whereon *Wm* Dwell, to be laid off on the West side of the Branch to him his Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath unto my beloved Son David the other half of the Tract of Land whereon *Wm* Dwell, to be laid off to him on the east side of the Branch after his Mother's Death or when at Age to him his Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give and bequeath to my beloved Daughter Ann two pounds to be raised out of my personal Estate to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath to my beloved Daughter Mary two pounds together with what she has already received to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath to my Daughter Jane a Horse value eight pounds a Saddle & Bridle a Rod & Furniture and four Cows & to her her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Appa a Horse value eight pounds, a Saddle & Bridle a Rod & Furniture and four Cows to her her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Hannah a Horse value eight pounds a Saddle & Bridle, a Rod & Furniture and four Cows to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Margaret, a Horse value eight pounds, a Rod & Furniture, Saddle & Bridle & four Cows to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* I give & bequeath unto my beloved Daughter Elizabeth eight pounds a Saddle & Bridle and four Cows to her, her Heirs & Assigns forever.

65) *Wm* I order my Son John half a years schooling, also I order my Son David two Years Schooling & more if my Executors see need full. Also I order my Daughter Elizabeth three Years Schooling, and the Cost of Schooling to be calculated & taken off the Estate before any publick sale be made of what is not here willed & bequeathed. *Wm* it is my will & pleasure, that what of my Estate is not here willed & bequeathed be sold by publick Vendue, & the Value thereof to be equally among these my Children Viz. Aaron, John, David, Jane, Appa, Hannah, Margaret, Elizabeth to them their Heirs & Assigns forever. *Wm* It is my will & pleasure if any of my Children should die before they come to age, that then what I have herein willed and bequeathed be sold by my Executors and equally divided among the then surviving Children. *Wm* I make & declare this my last Will & Testament in full of what I have herein willed & bequeathed by the said David Houston as his last Will & Testament in full of what I have herein willed & bequeathed.

In the Name of God Amen I Thomas Stuart of the County of North Carolina Planters, being weak of Body but of perfect Memory & understanding declare this to be my last Will & Testament in full of what I have herein willed & bequeathed. First & principally I commend my Soul into the Hands of Almighty God that gave it & my Body to be decently buried at the Discretion of my Executors hereafter named. *Wm* I give unto my eldest Son *Thomas Stuart* the one half of the Tract of Land whereon *Wm* Dwell, beginning on the South End of the

66) I give unto my Son Thomas Hunt the remaining half
of the said tract of Land wherein I now live except only that my
Wife Anne Hunt shall have the benefit of tilling the said Land
as long as she continues my Widow. - I give unto my
Wife Anne Hunt all my working Tools & two Horses (to wit) a
bay Horse known by the Name of Knuck & a grey Horse which I
purchased of Isaac Thomas, the grey Horse to be hers to dis-
pose of as she sees fit, the bay Horse to be hers as long as she
continues my Widow, but provided she marry the one half
of the working Tools to be divided amongst all my Sons the
other half to the said Widow, & the said bay Horse to be sold and
the Money to be equally divided among my Daughters. -

I give unto my Wife Anne Hunt four Cows (to wit) Stephen
Cherry, Browmy and Blacky and and the rest of my stock of
Cattle to be divided equally amongst my Children by my
Executors. - I give unto my Daughter Sarah Hunt one
young bay mare which has usually been called hers. I give
unto my Daughter Ruth Hunt one black Mare & young Colt
running at Peter Kings. I give unto my Son Jacob Hunt
one young bay mare running at Peter Kings. I give
unto my Daughter Jennima Hunt one young mare running with
one of Rich Williams. I give unto my Son William
one brown mare running at the great lick. I provide
my Wife be with Child, one year old Colt running at great lick,
with the brown Mare. I give to my Son Epham Hunt
the first bay Mare given to my Daughter Sarah
Hunt & I desire that two Horses (to wit) a grey Horse
I purchased from William Robinson and a black Horse I pur-
chased of John Hoggate be sold & the money to be equally divided
between my three Sons Jacob Hunt William Hunt and Epham Hunt.
I give unto my Daughter Mary Robinson, wife of

Shup & likewise my Stock of Hogs to be for the Family's use. 67
I give unto my wife Anne Hunt the one half of my household goods
and the other half I give to be divided amongst my Daughters by my Ex-
ecutors. I give my wearing Cloaths to be given to be disposed
of amongst my Sons as my Wife sees proper. I desire that my
Wife & Maggon be sold and the Money to be given to my Wife to dis-
pose of as she sees fit, and I do hereby constitute & appoint my Wif-
eth Charles Hunt my Friend Nathan Dickie and my loving Wife Anne
Hunt whole & sole Executors of this my last Will & Testament, and
by revoking & making void all other & former Wills Legacies and
Testaments by me made. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my
Hand & Seal this thirteenth Day of October A.D. 1760

out of my Estate find or cause to be fixed one Acre of Ground about
the Meeting House for a Burying place for the Inhabitants and that
it be done in a proper Manner for such a Term as may be most
