perfect Mind & Memory. Thanks be given unto God therefore
calling unto Mind the Mortality of my Body & knowing that
it is appointed for all men once to die, Do make & ordain this
my last Will & Testament; that is to say, principally & first
of all I give & recommend my Soul into the Hands of God that
gave it & for my Body I recommend it to the Earth, to be bur-
ied in a Christian like & decent Manner, at the Disposition of
my Executors, nothing doubting but at the general Resurrection,
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, &
as touching such worldly Estate wherewith it hath pleased God
to bless me in this Life; I give bequeath & dispose of the
same in the following manner & form. I ordain my funeral
charges to be paid of the whole of my Estate: & ^{also} I ordain what
Debts is due to my Estate to pay as far as they will reach
of Debts which I justly owe and if any remains unpaid
they shall be paid off the whole of my Estate. In witness I give
and bequeath to Lilly my dearly beloved Wife during her
natural Life one third part of my Land with all the Clear-
ground & improvements. Also one third part of all the move-
ables with the use of one gray Mare. Item I give my wife
Lilly ^{one} John Thomas & Robert all my Land equally
to be divided amongst them. & Robert shall have all the
Mother's Dicks in his part of the Land. Also Robert shall
have one bay Tilly. Also I give John all my Clops & Saddle
with one gray Tilly. Also I give Thomas one black mare &
Saddle to be paid for off the whole Estate. Item I give my
well beloved Daughter Martha one Mare & Saddle to be paid
for off the whole of my Estate. & when she goes for her self
she shall have an equal share of the Stock & movables

that is over her Mother's Estate. I ordain that the four youngest Child-
ren (viz) Robert, Sarah, Mary & Phibey shall be schooled & maintained
in what Deink washing & Lodging with sufficient Clothys at the
publick Charge of all the Family. I also ordain that Sarah, Mary and
Phibey shall have an equal share of the Stock as they arrive at age
or goes to be for themselves with my wife Friends to be equally divided
amongst the three (viz) my Wifes Friends of the movables at her
Death. I also ordain that all the Income of all the above mentioned
Marie be equally divided amongst the whole Family. I also con-
stitute make & ordain my well beloved Wife Lilly & John McConnell
Executors of this my last Will and Testament. In witness whereof

First I give & bequeath to Mary my dearly beloved Wife the Third of my Movables Estate of her living of the Place while she remains my Widow. And also I allow the Land to be divided between the two Boys And also I allow the Movables after her Death is taken out to be divided equally among the four Children Also I allow that my Children are to be bound out according to the Disposition of my Executors. Also I likewise constitute make & ordain Thomas Galloway & John McDonald sole Executor of this my last Will & Testament. And I do hereby utterly disallow, revoke & disannul all & every other former Testimony Wills Legacies Bequests & Executors by me in any Way before named, willed & bequeathed, ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness I have hereunto set my Hand & Seal this nineteenth Day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & sixty six.

same Do declare & appoint this my last Will & Testament as follows and herein that it may be recorded by all whom it may concern as such. Imprimis, I most humbly bequeath my Soul to God my Maker and Redeemer and satisfy his most gracious acceptance of it through the Merits of my confidential Saviour Jesus Christ who gave himself an offering for my sins & is able to save to the uttermost all that come unto God by him saving his own life to make Intercession for them in whom he trust he will not reject me a returning penitent when I come to him for Mercy. In this Act of Confidence I lay up my Soul with comfort humbly beseeching the most glorious Trinity our eternal God to prepare me for the time of my dissolution & that he take me to himself into that Paradise and Rest which he hath prepared for all those that love & fear his holy Name Amen — His witness. — Imprimis I give my Body to the earth from whence it was taken in full assurance of its Resurrection there at the last Day & for my Burial I desire it may be buried therefore at the Discretion of my Executors herein after mentioned where to be sent with marking it with prudence & gravity And aske my worthy Friends with it hath pleased God to bless me I will & particularly order the same in the following Manner & Form after payment of all my Debts & funeral Expenses. Now I absolutely give & bequeath unto my well beloved youngest Son Benjamin Grove one Negro man his name being the Young Black Horse called & named so also my macker the Young boy with all the Trucks Bolsters & Blankets that belongs to it & two pairs of Calfs to wit Brindel & Twin Also one Polor with the Green and a Sackling belonging to it & the big Pot & Little Pot & the Chest & Dugout Chack Box & Gridle & also an I allow my Negro woman to be his for four years after my Dispossession then to be sold by my Executors to the best price herein after directed I allow the Quittant of this to bear to be before this present Deed all the above as it stands stated to him & his heirs forever. Item I give devise & demise unto my will behest son Joseph one pot & one pukin Kegon to him & his Heirs forever. Item I give devise & demise & bequeath unto my well beloved Daughter Mary Rose my
