divided amongst my daughters by my executors I will
and bequeath that my well beloved son Peter Stiger-
walt shall have all my land or role estate what ever
I claim in North Carolina on both sides of the line
between Rowan County and Cabarrus County it may
contain what ever the Court of said County will allow it
to be and I positively order that my son Peter Stigerwalt
shall have out of my estate one bay bawl Mare and another
chestnut bay bawl Mare and one two years old sorrel
bawl horse Couple and he shall have out of my estate
two rows and four calves such articles shall be given
to him out of my Estate by my executors, for him and
his heirs forever and I do constitute them my well

I Thomas Swann of the County of Rowan and
State of N. Carolina being weak in body but of perfect
mind and memory do this Twenty sixth day of November
in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and ninety
five make, ordain and publish this my last will and
testament in the following manner Viz

First I give and bequeath to my son son William
and daughter Elizabeth to each of them one dollar

I order that my son Thomas be put to a trade against
next fall. And likewise my son Isaac as soon as his
mother thinks he can be spared. And to each of them
fifteen pounds as soon as free of their apprenticeship
to be lived out of my estate

To my daughter Ann Lowrance I give and bequeath
ten pounds. And to my daughter Martha Allen I
give and bequeath thirty pounds, to be lived out of
my estate as soon as a division takes place or sooner
if convenient.

I give and bequeath the remainder of my movable Estate to my wife Catharina, ~~and~~ son Matthew, Living and daughters Mary, Catharine and Margaret to be apportioned among them, which division shall take place when my wife ceases to be my widow; and if she ceases to be my widow by death her part to be equally divided among my five last mentioned children with which I allow my wife to have the management and superintendence of my family affairs.

Lastly I give and bequeath to my son Matthew and James my plantation to be equally divided between them after their mothers death.

And I do hereby otherwise appoint and ordain my wife Catharina & Abraham Lawrence to be my executors of this my last will & testament. And I do hereby revoke and disannul all former wills and bequeath publish and declare this to be my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal the day and the year above written.

I Adam Sprack Sen. of Rowan County in the State of North Carolina, Planter, being in good health and of sound and disposing mind and memory, thanks be given to God, do make and ordain this my last will and testament. to wit First of all I recommend my soul into the hands of my dear Lord Jesus Christ who gave it, and my Body to be buried in the united Brethrens burying ground at Friedberg. And as touching my worldly Estate, I give and bequeath the same in the manner following, to wit.

1. I give & bequeath unto my dear son Gottlieb Sprack Twenty five Dollars lawfull money of the United States, and unto my dear son Jacob Sprack Twenty five Dollars like money and unto my deceased daughters Marys Children Christina Permer, the wife of Joseph Permer and Gottlieb Maria Permer Spinster to each of them One Dollar like money.

2. I give and bequeath all the remainder of my personal estate to my dear sons Adam, John, Gottlieb, Jacob, Joseph, and to my dear daughters Rovina, Mary Elizabeth & Anna Sabina to be divided among them share & share alike, according to the appraisement of my movable goods by two indifferent men appointed by my Executors, together with any notes, bonds or money I may die possessed of.

3. I do hereby make, ordain constitute & appoint my dear son Gottlieb Sprack of Stokes County and my beloved friend Lazarus Hoge of Rowan County, executors of this my last will & test. jointly & separately, and do hereby disannul & make void all my former wills or legacies by me here written in writing or by word of mouth, ratifying & confirming these presents and no other to be my last will & Test.
