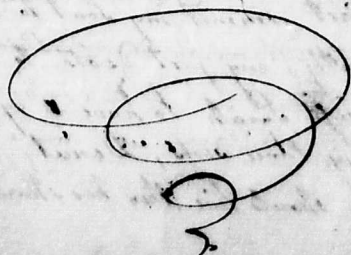


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divided between the said three sons, Daniel, William, & John, also I give to Sarah my wife a equal part of my property personal to be equally divided between said wife Sarah & my daughter Mary, & Daniel and William & John except forty Dollars is to be redacted out of Mary part & then to be equally divided between the said five persons my sd. wife Sarah, Mary, Daniel, William & John also one cow calf & heifer by the name of Beaman is excepted that I give & fifty Dollars in cash to my son Daniel extraordinary more to him any of the rest out of the estate. I also desire as soon as may be convenient after my death that my property may be sent to sale & the money to be put out on interest & paid to my children as they come of age I also appoint my brother Daniel Wood whole & sole executor of this my last will. Signed, sealed in the presence of us the 2 Day of December: 1805.

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In the name of God Amen! I Thomas White of Rowan County & State of N. Carolina being very old & weak but of perfect mind & memory thanks be to God laying to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men to die I do make & ordain this my last will & test: that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul in the hands of God almighty that gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent Christian burial at the discretion of my executors hereafter named nothing doubting but I shall at the general resurrection receive the same again by the mighty power of God & as touching such worldly estate wherewith it had pleased God to bless me with in this life I give demise & dispose of in the following manner: first my will & desire is that all my just debts be immediately paid out of my estate at the discretion of my executors hereafter named.

Item. Secondly my will & desire is that my land given to me by virtue of my father Joseph White's will. Shall be sold by my executors & the money therefrom to be laid out, for lands in the State of N. Carolina at the discretion of my executors hereafter named. Also: the above mentioned land lays in Annapolis County State of Maryland & that of the rest of my legacies left me in my father's will shall be left to my executors to sell it then or bring it to North Carolina which they think is best for my wife & children.

Item I lent to my beloved wife Sarah White all the land
that my executors may purchase with the money that my
Maryland, land sell for with my whole sole estate of every
kind what so ever except one feather bed & furniture
& one side saddle during her natural life & after the death
of my beloved wife my will & desire is that the whole of
my estate both real & personal shall be equally divided
between my children as follows Amalia, Joseph, Charley,
William, Thomas, Asa & Mary & Benne White & their
& their heirs for ever.

Item I give to my beloved daughter Amalia White
one feather bed & furniture & one side saddle to her own
use, if my wife sees cause to give a part of the estate
to any of the children while she liveth the executor
must it have appraised so that they may account for it
at the division of the estate, this being my last will &
test: I do hereby appoint my beloved son Joseph White
Josiah Oen to be my whole & sole executors to this my
last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & seal this 14. of January AD 1801.
