give it to him sooner. And I do appoint my Wife Mary  
and my son Jacob and make them Executors of this  
my last Will and Testament in Witness whereof  
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this 7<sup>th</sup> day  
of January Anno Domini 1779. Teste publico and  
Advised by the above named Isaac Wiseman for  
and as his last Will and Testament in the presence

In the name of God Amen I William Stuart of Rowan  
and Province of North Carolina Planter being very sick and  
weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be  
given unto God calling to mind the mortality of my body  
and knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die  
do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament  
That is to say and first of all, I give and recommend

my soul into the hands of Almighty God that gave it  
and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried  
in decent Christian burial at the discretion of my Ex-  
ecutors not doubting but at the general Resurrection  
I shall receive the same again by the mighty power  
of God and as touching such worldly Estate where-  
with it hath pleased God to bless me in this life, I  
give devise and Dispose of the same in the follow-  
ing manner and form, First I give and bequeath  
to my dearly beloved Wife Elizabeth Stewart whom  
I make constitute and ordain my sole Executrix  
of this my last Will and Testament all and sin-  
gular my lands tenements and Messuages by her  
and my Children fully to be possessed and enjoyed  
without any Divisions distributions or the like during  
the Minority of my two youngest Children namely  
William and Thomas Stewart whom when of age  
I allow and order in this my last Will and Testament  
that my Estate may be equally distributed and divided  
between and betwixt my Children and Wife giving  
each party an equal share, untill which time I  
Request that they all may continue together in  
the same Unity as hitherto, except in case of

Marriage or the like lawful cause of absence). When  
 the Party so vacating or betaking himself away  
 from the family or Jurisdiction of his mother, her  
 they is or are to get his or their share in proportion  
 to one or either of the said and in case of death the  
 Person or Persons so happening in by this my last  
 Will prohibited from bequeathing any part of  
 said Estate — out of the family untill the  
 time of distribution abovementioned the said Eliza-  
 beth Stewart to have the sole management of all  
 affairs all and every of the children to be ruled  
 by her untill said time of distribution, I further  
 allow my Oldest son Robert Stewart and Hugh Penny  
 to assist the said Elizabeth my Wife in the manage-  
 ment distribution &c of said Estate, but nothing to be  
 contrary to said Elizabeths will, whom I appoint  
 as chief till my said time of distribution, at which  
 time she is to get her equal share, either in the state  
 of Widowhood or otherwise, I further allow my Mother  
 Janet Stewart her maintenance of said Estate  
 her life time and also a Christian decent burial  
 And I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and  
 Disannull all and every other former testam<sup>ts</sup>

Wills legacies, bequests and Executorships  
 in any ways before named Willed and  
 bequeathed Ratifying and confirming this  
 and no other to be my last Will and Tes-  
 tament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
 set my hand and seal this second day of  
 April in the sixth Year of our Independence  
 and in the Year of our Lord Christ 1781. Be  
 it known further that I allow my younger  
 Children to be educated out of said Estate that  
 to read and write &c Signed Sealed published  
 pronounced and declared by the said Rob<sup>t</sup>  
 Stewart as his last Will and Testament in  
 the presence of us who in his presence and  
 in the presence of each other have hereunto  
 subscribed Names
