make & renew constitute this my last will &

I recommend it to the earth to be buried in a  
Christian like manner at the discretion of  
my executor. Nothing doubting but at the  
general Resurrection I shall receive the same  
again by the almighty power of God. And as  
touching such worldly estate wherewithal it hath  
pleased God to bless me with I give devise and  
dispose of in the following manner & form  
to wit First I give with and bequeath to my  
daughter Mary Thomas Adams Rachael  
Cornelius Smiths wife my large Bible and  
four shillings sterling if legally demanded  
Secondly I give with bequeath to my Daughter  
Mary Thomas Adams wife one feather bed

and bedding six poster plates one poster dish one iron pan  
pot now in the possession of the said Thomas Adams.  
Thirdly I give with bequeath to my son John Lynn  
one foal horse one saddle and bridle and two Tarts of  
Oats & pair of saddle bags now in his possession  
Fourthly I give with bequeath to my son Israel Lynn a  
set of blacksmith tools Fifthly I give with bequeath  
to my son William hanning Lynn one bay colt one  
cow and three calves and thirty hours in the hands  
of Edward Hughes Millwright Sixthly I give with  
bequeath to my Daughters Sarah and Hannah an  
equal part of my personal estate with my son Ben-  
jamin Lynn after my wife Mary has got her third part  
seventhly I give with bequeath to my beloved wife  
one third part of my personal estate and all her  
estate that she brought with her when I married her  
Eighthly Lastly I give with bequeath to my son  
Henry Lynn all that allayage and tract of land  
in Rowan County wherein I now live to have and  
to hold after my death and an equal part of my  
personal estate with his two Sisters Sarah & Hannah  
before named when they marry or go away.  
And I do hereby make ordain & constitute & appoint  
Chary my wife & my beloved friend James May  
Councillors of this my last will & Testament to take care  
yea that the same be performed according to my true  
intent & meaning in witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand & seal the day & year above written. I sign  
and affirme this instrument by the said William Lynn as his last  
will & testament in presence of William Lynn
