Likewise to deed my dearly beloved son I bequeath fifty pounds. Item I give and bequeath to Robert my dearly beloved son, his wearing Apparel, a mare Colt one year old and the Appurment or which I now live. The Remainder of my Stock, Hogs, Piggons and Tacklings and Log Chain to be old and the Money arising from sale to be equally divided among Sam, Robert John and Rebecca, except the third of the Hog or price as expressed above: and the same mentioned to my other Children. I likewise constitute and appoint John Reed and my son John Reed Executors of this my last Will and Testament. And I do hereby attest repeal revoke and revoke all and every other Former Testaments, Wills Legacies and Bequestments, by me in any Manner before named writes and bequeaths ratifying and confirming this my last Will and Testament.
