& memory, I thank God therefore, calling unto mind
the mortality of my body knowing that it is appointed
for all men once to die, do therefore ordain this my last
will & testament & first of all I give & recommend my soul
into the hands of almighty God that gave it & my body
to be buried in decent christian burial, & of such worldly
estate as it has pleased God to bless me in this world
I give & bequeath of the same in the following manner.
First I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Elizabeth
Warner my plantation whereon I now live, to her the said
Elizabeth Warner to live on, & to have the benefit of said
plantation her life time further I give & bequeath unto
my beloved wife Elizabeth Warner, all my household
furniture & working tools of what ever denomination,
& two horse creatures viz one mare & one horse & two
cows & calfs. all of which moveable property heretofore
mentioned I leave to her the said Elizabeth Warner's own use.
Further I give & bequeath unto my beloved sons John
& William Warner my plantation with all my land
belonging to it being about three hundred acres to be
equally divided to them after the above named Elizabeth
Warner's decease.
Further I give & bequeath unto my eldest daughter

Letitia Moore the sum of five shillings to be lived
out of my estate.
Further I give & bequeath to my youngest daughter
Nancy Cooper the sum of five shillings to be lived out
of my estate.
My will is further that out of my other property not
heretofore mentioned there shall be money raised to pay all
lawfull debts that I may have heretofore created & the
remainder equally divided to them hereafter named viz
to my beloved wife Elizabeth Warner & my beloved son
John Warner & William Warner & to my beloved
daughters Maria Wilson & Sarah Lannon.

Further I give & bequeath unto my beloved Grandson
Daniel Warner my young bay horse.
