 men once to die do make ordain this my last will & test
 First of all I recommend my soul to God & my body to
 be buried decently. And as touching such worldly estate
 where with it had pleased God to bless me in this life
 I give devise & dispose of in following manner & form.
 First I give & bequeath to my beloved son Peter Hel-
 mettatter two hundred acres of land whereon he now lives
 being part of my plantation where on I now live &
 being part of a tract of four hundred acres of land.
 Secondly I give & bequeath unto my beloved son Christen
 Helmettatter two hundred acres of land whereon he now
 lives being part of the four hundred acres before mentioned.
 Thirdly my will is that each of my two sons above named
 pay unto my beloved daughters to wit Elizabeth &
 Mary Gobel the price of twenty five acres of land that
 is to say fifty acres out of all my land above willed
 to be paid according to the valuation of two neighboring
 freeholders.
 Fourth I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Maria
 Magdalena Helmettatter all my goods & cattles to-
 gether with all my household furniture, one mare
 two cows & four head of sheep for her maintenance during
 her lifetime, & what ever of the last said property

may be too expensive for my sd beloved wife to keep, my
 will is that my executors sell such property as she my
 beloved wife may see proper to part with it & deliver the
 money to her for her to live upon, and my will is further
 that my beloved wife shall have her free liberty & choice
 to choose a place to have her a house built on my land
 above willed, & that my two sons above named shall build
 her a house whenever she may request it.

And for the better performance of this my last will & test
 I do appoint my trusty friends John Goble sen. & John
 Goble jun. Executors of this my last will & test. Signed
 sealed pronounced & delivered in the presence of two
~~witnesses~~ the presence of each other have hereunto set our
 hands 3 April 1807.

In the name of God: I William Wiseman of the
 County of Rowan & State of N. Carolina planter, being
 weak in body but of perfect mind & memory. Calling to
 mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is
 appointed for all men to die, do make & ordain this my
 last will & testament that is to say principally &
 first. I recommend my soul to God & my body to be
 decently buried at the discretion of my executors, And
 as touching such worldly goods where with it had
 pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise

I dispose of in following manner & form
 First I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Ann the plantation whereon I now live, likewise all the moveable property that I now possess all to be for her use, so long as she remains a widow in my name, likewise I give & bequeath to my beloved son Thimothy Wireman the plantation whereon he now lives, beginning at Roberts line near the branch running along a conditional line between his plantation & mine to Harpers line, likewise one horse & one cow & calf which he now had in possession, likewise I give & bequeath all the remainder part of sd tract of land to Will^m Wireman & Isaac Wireman to be equally divided between them but Will^m have his part joining Wingers line & Kellego line likewise I give to Will^m Wireman one young horse with a bad face, likewise I give to Isaac Wireman choice of my horse creatures all to be after the decease of my mother likewise I do allow after the decease of my wife the tract of land joining George Reed & Will^m Ford to be sold at publick sale & the money to be equally divided between seven of my daughters to wit. Margaret Kallmstulles, Mary Hunt Johanna Hunt Nancy, Elizabeth, Rachel & Ann Wireman likewise after the decease of my wife I allow my four young daughters each to have one bed & furniture, one cow & calf likewise I allow all the remaining part of my household furniture to be equally divided among all my daughters, likewise I allow all my Iron Tools

of every kind to be equally divided amongst all my sons likewise I allow all the remaining part of my moveable property not here willed to be sold at publick sale & the money to be equally divided amongst all my children likewise I allow my wife one tract of land lying on the waters of patros creek joining Nicolas Simons line & Maxwell Chambers line containing one hundred acres to be at her disposal to sell & live on for her support so long she shall live if she not should sell sd land in her life after her decease I allow it to be sold at publick sale & the money to be equally divided amongst all my daughters or if she should sell sd land and not make use of all the money the remaining part of the money I allow to go all to my daughters, & for the better execution of this my last will I hereby appoint my wife Ann & my son in law Ezra Hunt to be the executor of this my last will & test: & I do hereby utterly disallow & revoke all & every other will, legacies, executors etc by me in any wise before made. Ratify & confirm this & no other to be my last will & test. In witness whereof I have herunto set my hand & seal 17 Day of Septor 1805.
