 will & test. I recommend my soul to God who gave it, &
 my body to the dust from whence it was taken to be buried in
 a decent manner at the discretion of my executors.
 I give & bequeath to my daughter Hannah one cow & calf &
 one loom, I give & bequeath to my son Thomas, one bag mare
 which I now own, the remainder of my stock with all my mo-
 veable property after all lawful debts are discharged to be sold
 at public sale & divided equally among my children. I sign among
 all my rights & titles to all my land to be divided among all my
 sons as they may think best. I do appoint & constitute Wm. Cranfield
 & Abraham Ball executors to this my last will & test:

In the name of God Amen! I Yeuse Catz of Rowan
 County in the State of N. Carolina, farmer; being very sick &
 weak in body but of perfect sound sense & memory Thanks be to
 God for the same. I now call unto mind the mortality of
 the body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die
 I do for the purpose of disposing of my words by property
 & to settle all my affairs in full, with every person make &
 ordain this to be my last will & test: I give my soul to God
 who gave it, my body to the earth to be buried in a decent christen
 And as touching my worldly estate, wherewith God had blessed
 me in this life, I give & dispose of the same in the following form.

1. I give & bequeath unto my well beloved wife Mary her beds &
 bedstead & furniture belonging to the same. I give her one
 choice of my horse creatures one cow her spinning wheel & saddle
 & bridle one bushel of salt - flax - cotton & wool as much as she
 will need for the first year after my death it is my will that
 my wife shall reap wheat, corn & pork as much as will serve
 her for the first year after my death & I give her a peaceable
 possession of my dwelling room & other necessary priviledges
 of my dwelling house during her widowhood I give to my wife
 a small pot, bason & 6 spoons.

2. I give & bequeath unto my son George my plantation
 & dwelling where I now live for ever, but shall comply with
 the following condition (to wit) he the said son George shall
 find feed for his mothers creatures as I have given her & he
 the said son shall find his mother yearly with sufficient
 wheat, corn, & meat during her widowhood & shall also find
 her shoes & stockings yearly during her widowhood then if my said

son George shall & will comply with all I require of him in this my last will, then he shall inherit & enjoy my lands as mentioned above for ever. - I further give unto him the said George my gray mare - he shall further sow a quartre of a acre with flax seed yearly for my wife during her widowhood.

3. I give & bequeath unto my two youngest sons Michel & Philips seventy pounds each. I also give unto my two youngest sons each of them their rifle gun with their horse road. I will that my after named executors shall sell all my personal property excepting such as I have given, and the money arising from the said sale shall be taken to pay the above sum of seventy pounds to my sons Michael & Philips. If the sale of my property do not amount sufficient for to pay the said seventy pounds to each of my youngest sons, then in that case my two sons John & George shall make up the seventy pounds to each of my said youngest sons in case my personal property should amount to more then the seventy pounds - the ballance shall be equally divided amongst my wife & children, in case either or both of my youngest sons should die before the arise of age or get their said sum of seventy pounds - his said sum shall be equally divided amongst the rest wife & children.

And I do hereby constitute & appoint my two sons John & George executors of this my last will & test. in witness whereof the s^d Yount Latz have hereunto set my hand & seal this 14th day of October 1798.

I Henry Clement of the County of Rowan & State of N^c Carolina, Planter, being very weak in body but of perfect mind & memory Thanks be given unto God calling to mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die. I do make & ordain this my last will & test: that is to say principally I give & recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body to the earth to be buried in a decent christian burial at the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God, & as touching such worldly estate where with it had pleased God to bless me in this life I give demise Dispose of the same in the following manner & form.

1. I give & bequeath to my beloved wife Sophiah the planter or tract of land whereon I now live together with other joining to it containing fifty two acres likewise as much of my moveable property of every kind as she shall think fit to keep so long as she shall live, if she is like to waste or destroy the said property that she shall keep it shall be taken from her & sold & give her as much as will be sufficient for her to live upon. Likewise I do allow my two youngest sons to have two cows & calves to be equal with my two oldest sons or the worth of them in money. Likewise I do allow all my Daughters to have each one, one horse & two cows & calves to be equal with my sons or the worth of them in money or some thing else that suits them Likewise I do allow each one of my Daughters six pounds per year
