John & my son in law my executors to this my last will & test.

I give to my daughter Elizabeth Harris one Loom & one
leather bed & furniture & 1 leather trunk & 1 painted Box.

I give to my two youngest sons Samuel & James Harris
all my cloaths & my saddle & bridle & all my carpenters
& coopers tools. I also will that all the rest of my stock &

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& household & kitchen furniture with all my plantation
tools & moveable property be equally divided between
my beloved wife & my Daughters Elisabeth Harris, &
my two sons Samuel & James Harris Item I constitute
Hoody Jones & Roland Jones my sole executors to this my
last will & testament In witness whereof I have set my
hand & seal this 15 Day of August 1798.

comes to the years of majority my dwelling house & plant-
ation whereon I now live & first choice of my stock of horse
& manumitting.

Fourthly I give & bequeath unto my beloved
daughter Ann Howard one negro girl named Amy
& then the rest of my property to be sold & equally
divided among my wife & three young & old children &
lastly I constitute & ordain my beloved Father William
Howard my whole & only executor of this my last will
& test. signed sealed & acknowledged to be my last
will & testament this second day of October 1802.
