Quinn, Sean Quinn, Oliver Quinn, Mary Quinn
& Margaret Quinn and when the young
Couns to age it shall be divided equally
as the nature of the property will admit, & that which
not conveniently divide shall be sold & the money that
arising to be equally divided ~~between~~ them all. I
do hereby utterly disallow revoke & disannul all and
every other former testaments, wills, legacies, bequests and
executors by me in any wise named Will & and
guaranteed, ratifying & confirming this and no other
my last will and testament. In witness whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and seal this fifth day
of June in the year of our Lord one thousand

eight hundred & fourteen

Records of October Court 1822

In the name of God Amen. I John Nelson son of the
County of Rutland State of North Carolina being of
sound and perfect mind & memory blessed be God for
his mercies do this third day of July 1822 make & publish
this my last will and testament in the manner following
I recommend my soul to God who gave it & my body
to be buried in a Christianlike manner

I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Margaret Nelson
the plantation where I now live including all the land
that I hold adjoining to the same, my two horses
Royal & Pill, all my farming utensils and implements
belonging to the plantation of every description, all
my household & kitchen furniture, Beds & Bedding and
all my implement belonging to the house & kitchen, all
my stock of Cattle except one cow & calf, all my hogs
& sheep, all my negroes that is Kate Liff & Will to remain
in her possession during her life time or widowhood.

I give & bequeath unto my daughter Elizabeth my negro girl named
Liff at my wife's demise or at any period that my wife does
choose to give her up; & likewise my yearling colt & one cow
& calf to have her living in the place with my wife
as long as she remains single.

I give unto my daughter Mary, wife of William Allen
one hundred Dollars.

I give unto my son James Nelson the plantation on
Grades Creek called Brackett's old place in case he
should live to return.

I allow all the balance of my property that remains in
my wife's possession real & personal at her decease or
changing from my widow, to be equally divided between my
son John Nelson, Samuel Nelson, James Nelson Thomas Nelson
& my daughter Elizabeth Nelson each an equal share
& in case that my son James should not live to return
I allow the Brackett place that is left to him &

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likewise his part of the above named property to be
by divided between the four above named, John,
Thomas & Elizabeth Wilson, & I hereby make & ordain
my son John Wilson & son Samuel Wilson & my
Thomas Wilson Executors of this my last will & tes-
tament

and bequeath to my dear beloved Child
Joseph McEntire all that I received of my
Father all other property, two horse beasts,
two Cows & Calves, One Yearold and Hogg-
corn & fodder all that is over one year
provision for my dear wife, to be sold for
money to be let out on Interest for my dear
Child Likewise I leave my Father William
McEntire Executor for my beloved Child
this 12th Day of November 1822. Signed
