

96 Wills - September 6th 1828.

In the name of God Amen.

I Rachael Grayson of the County of Rutherford and State of North Carolina being weak in body but of perfect mind and memory thanks be to God, calling to mind the mortality of my body and knowing that it is appointed for all men to die do make and ordain this my last will & Testament that is to say principally and first of all I leave and recommend my soul unto God that gave it, and my body I recommend to the Earth to be buried without the discretion of my executors nothing doubting but at the general resurrection I shall receive the same again by the mighty power of God: And as touching such worldly estate wherewith it hath pleased God to bless me within this life I give and dispose of the same in the following manner and form. - 1st All my lawful debts to be paid. - 2^d I leave and bequeath unto Jane Crow - all my body clothing except two silk handkerchiefs with one loom and all the utensils that belong to the same with all the Dilph ware that is on my dresser with one saddle she has in possession. - 3^d I leave and bequeath unto Rachel Crow - daughter of Jane Crow - one new side saddle with my largest buckskin and one scarlet cloak. - 4th I leave and bequeath unto Elizabeth Crow - one little wheel and my best oven. - 5th I leave and bequeath unto Leticia Crow - one big wheel one mortar & gallon pot with one chick reel. - 6th I leave and bequeath unto Elizabeth Crow & Leticia Crow - daughters of Jane Crow - one feather bed and under bed with the stead & cord & furniture

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said bed to be equally divided between the said Elizabeth and Leticia Crow. -

I leave and bequeath unto Isaac Crow - son of Jane Crow - five dollars each the money to be put to interest till they said boys are twenty one years old. -

I leave and bequeath unto John Crow - one twenty five dollars & 50 cents note to be delivered to him by my executor. - 7th I leave and bequeath

unto Lewis Vanzant all the remainder of my household furniture with all my stock of horses, cattle, hogs & sheep with one still and all the vessels belonging to the same with all my farming tools, with one log chain. - 10th I allow my executors to collect one nine dollar note off John Crow - and put it to interest and give it to the above named three sons of Jane Crow when they are twenty one years old. -

I appoint ~~constable~~ make & ordain Lewis Vanzant and Joseph Grayson joint my executors for this my last will and testament, and I do hereby disallow, revoke and disannul all other former testaments, Wills, legacies, bequeaths and entered by me in Wills made or done ratifying & confirming this & none but this to be my only last will and testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand seal this seventh of June one thousand eight hundred & twenty eight. -
