In the Name of God amen.

I William W. Entire of the County of Rutherford
and State of North Carolina being of sound mind and
memory blessed be God for his mercies, I do this day make
my last Will & Testament in the manner following viz.
1st I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife Rebecca W. Entire
four negr. v. Brister and Bob and Bine & Man and
all my horses, cattle, hogs and sheep, farming utensils
household and kitchen furniture during her natural
life or widowhood with the upper part of the plantation
where I now live including the house I live in with my
maggon and blacksmiths tools and still and v. B. &
during her life or widowhood. 2nd I give and
bequeath to my daughter Rhoda W. Brayer and the
heirs of her body three negr. named viz. Phebe,
Lucinda & Dick. 3rd I give and bequeath to my
daughter Rachel Covington and the heirs of her body three
negr. named viz. Eve & Hannah & Rhody and also at
the decease of my wife Rebecca W. Entire or her wid-
hood one negr. woman named Bine, also two hundred
acres of land bounded on George Raylors land and
Aaron Rapp lands on the corner tree branch. —
4th I give and bequeath unto my beloved son Prior
W. Entire three negr. named Adam & Sally, Abram
and then at the decease of my wife Rebecca W. Entire
or widowhood one negr. man named Bob and also
the plantation where he now lives and, from Cornwall's
ford running with the road from the ford of the river to
my still house, and at the death of my wife Rebecca
W. Entire the home plantation where I now live. —
5th I give and bequeath to my beloved daughter Dale
ia W. Entire, three negr. named Rosannah and
Susan and Peter also negr. Man at the decease of,

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widowhood of my wife Rebecca W. Entire to her and the heirs
of her body, also one horse saddle and bridle, two cows and
calves and two feather beds and necessary furniture for the
kitchen and a saw and pigs, two cows and lambs, one
desk and cupboard, — this desk and cupboard to be
my wife Rebecca W. Entire's her lifetime or widowhood
and also one hundred and fifty dollars in money
at my wife Rebecca W. Entire's decease, and also the
increase of the above named slave to go from now to go
to the said Quilcinia W. Entire & the heirs of her body. —
6th I give and bequeath to my grandsons Joseph W.
W. Entire one hundred and twenty acres of land
more or less adjoining lands of George Raylors and
David Covingtons and Prior W. Entire including
the plantation where my son Samuel W. Entire lived
to be his when he arrives to the age of twenty one years
and also one bed and necessary furniture. — and
at the death of my wife Rebecca W. Entire for them
all above named to come to an equal division
with the goods and chattels that is left to her that I have
not milled. — 7th I also appoint my son Prior W. Entire
and my wife Rebecca W. Entire executors to my last
will and testament. In witness hereof I the said
W. W. Entire do hereunto set my hand and seal this
ninth day of March one thousand eight
hundred and thirty one
