3) I give and bequeath unto my beloved Brother John

the sum of Fifty three and one third dollars money of
the United States and in case of his demise before
the payment of said sum I give the same to his
lawful begotten children in like shares
4) I give and bequeath unto my beloved Sister Anna
Benigna Baye of Pittaburie in Pennsylvania widow
& reliefs of the late Nicholas Lawrence Dyer of Pitta-
burie in Pennsylvania aforesaid deceased the sum
of One hundred & two & two thirds dollars of like
money as aforesaid. And I will that the two
last mentioned bequests shall by my executors be
paid respectively as above said within six months
next after my demise

5) I also give and bequeath unto my said beloved
wife Mary Salome for and during her
natural life all the interest which shall and
may be due of and on the remainder of my
Estates comprised & contained in this instrument

of Hand so that such interest you will
receive five per centum. And I will that
my said Executors the said principal sum
put out on interest and the said interest
pay as abovesaid unto my said wife
during her natural life yearly and my executors

of 'Distillation Deacon' the said Two hundred
and fifty Dollars by the said Society immediately
or receipt thereof to be paid unto the Rent
of Freddie William Marshall wif. of whom
in North Carolina or his Successor in office for
the execution use and benefit of the said institution
and the said two last Mentioned Regans &
Luns shall by my said Executors be paid
respectfully as aforesaid within three months
not after the decease of my said wife my

her natural life and then the whole hole
of the tract to be equal divided between
Peter Burton & Thornton Preston Green my
son in Law & one Item I also give to my
three daughers Hirs if any to well
Sarah Lucy & Nancy five shillings each
Item I give to my daughter Green Gittens on
the one half of my bed wherein she now
lives in Halifax County Virginia one negro
man named Mike all which she is to have
during her natural life then after her death
to go to her daughter Mary Gittens Item
I give to my Daughter Mary four one negro
woman name Hester their children and
their heirs. Item I give to my daughter
Rebekah Burton that tract tract of land
which I now live on half my stock cattle
Hogs Sheep & three hogsheads of tobacco one
negro woman named Amy & her children
Item I give to Thornton Preston Green the
balance of my Estates Rail & Personage
so with my plantation on the South side
