Whereunto I have hereunto set my hand and seal this twentieth Day of October one thousand seven hundred and ninety

Know all men by these presents that I Thomas McCarrall of Granville County in the state of South Carolina have this day bargained and sold confirmed and Delivered unto Mr Lewis of the county of Surry and state of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and sixty three pounds ten Shillings to me in hand paid by the said Mr Lewis the sum hereof I do hereby acknowledge that I have sold to said Mr Lewis three negroes by name Nelly about 15 years of age, two negro boys viz Tom and Putney each about Eleven months old and one Raccoon hatter which said negroes & Raccoon hatter I do warrant and forever defend unto the said Mr Lewis his heirs & assigns from me the said Thomas McCarrall my heirs & assigns and against all an every other person or persons shall and will warrant & forever defend unto the said Mr Lewis his heirs or assigns In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this 10th Day of June 1790. be it remembered
