of Stokes County State of North Carolina being of sound
perfect mind & memory Do hereby give for his merits
do this the twentieth day of June in the year of
our Lord one thousand seven hundred & ninety eight
make & publish this to be my last will & testament
in manner following that is to say First I give and
bequeath to my son John Bartick instead of the land
he lives on One Negro girl now in his possession
namely together with a bond on Eliza Perkins for
Two hundred Dollars = Also I give & bequeath to my
son Abalom Bartick the land he now lives on con-
taining two hundred and fifty acres also fifty
acres joining the said land which I bought of Mark
Hardin also one hundred and fifty acres joining
him on the West and part of the tract of land
I bought of Charles McAnnally containing 309
acres also Six Negroes now in his possession
Sally Charlotte George Isaac Lane & Hannah with
all their increase from the time of his possession
Also I give and bequeath to my son Ferdinand
Bartick Seven hundred & ninety six acres of land
which I bought of William Meredith situate in
Stokes County lying on the head of Beeson Island
frank also one bed & furniture and three Negroes
one Negro man named James one woman
named Jib one boy named Stephen = Also I
give and bequeath to my son Mansah Bartick all the land
whereon I now live on both sides of Dan river containing
Eight hundred & Sixty six acres plus one hundred joining

Lanena Angell & Thomas have nearly Two hundred acres on
the south side of Dan river joining the land of Lanena Angell
nearly all the land whereon I now live in dividing the land of
plantation my son John Bartick now lives together with
one hundred and fifty acres I bought of Charles McAnnally
in the hole one thousand & fifty acres also seven Negroes David
Liny Barlow bibles Francis York Williamson my young boy name
man of the one & a half head of furniture = Also I give and
bequeath to my daughter Bethenia three Negroes Sarah
Delphi Selah with all their increase from the time the land
into possession of them = Also I give & bequeath to my daughter
Susanna three Negroes Mary Solomon Daniel free son =
Also I give and bequeath to my daughter Anne three Negroes
Bess Rhoda & Mrs. Harrison = Also I give & bequeath to
my daughter Christiana three Negroes Hagar Mariah &
Dick four head of sheep two from Hagar one feather bed
& furniture to remain in the hands of my wife until my
daughter Christiana is 19 years of age or married all my
will & desire is that the bond which I have on William T. Lewis
for Two thousand acres of land shall be divided in the manner
following five hundred acres to my son John Bartick five
hundred acres to my son Abalom Bartick two hundred
& fifty acres to each of my daughters Bethenia Susanna
Anne & Christiana = I also leave to my loving wife Seven
Negroes during her natural life and after her decease
to be equally divided between my son John Bartick
Abalom Bartick Ferdinand Bartick Bethenia Hampton
Susanna Blackburn Anne Guin & Christiana Bartick =
It is my will & desire that after my just debts is paid
that at the residue of my estate real & personal which

which is not before mentioned to give & bequeath to
my son Manoah Bartick I also do appoint my
son Manoah my sole & sole executor in witness
whereof I have hereunto set my hand and affixed
my seal the day & date above written
