the said Robert Smith well warrant
and favour defend the aforesaid negro
Frank from the claim of any persons
& from me & my heirs forever unto the
above named Robert Mashburn him
& his heirs as witness my hand this 31st
Day of July the thousand seven hundred
& sixty

Folk of Surry County and State of North Carolina
do hereby in good health & of perfect memory
thanks be given unto God, calling unto mind
the shortness of my life and knowing that
it is appointed for all them once to dye do
make and a give this my last will & testament
that is to say principally & first of all I give
& recommend my soul unto the hands of almighty
god & my body I recommend to the earth to be
buried in Decent Christian burial at the direction
of my Executors nothing doubting but at the general
resurrection I shall receive the same again by the
mighty power of god and as touching such
worldly Estate wherewith it has pleased god to
bless me in this life I give & devise and bequeath
of the same in the following manner to wit
First All my debts to be paid and paid out of this
my Estate.

Second I give & bequeath unto my beloved wife Mary
Marganther all my house hold furniture of or
her only proper use & behoof for ever besides
all my Cattle Sheep Hogs whatsoever belonging
to me excepting my land & horses.

Thirdly I give unto my beloved son Andrew Folk my land
a Plantation whereon I now live for his
only proper use & behoof forever besides
two Acres land for the same land and

Lower the said Andrew Folk is to give every year as long as I and my wife shall live twenty Bushels of Wheat twenty bushels of Indian Corn one hundred weight of good hog meat besides he is to plow blow yearly one half acre of flax seed in good ground for me and my wife as long as we shall live besides he is to find food enough for one Cow of my wife means to have one heifer which is to allow out of this my land one quarter Acre of land suitable for raising of good Garden trees

Fourthly I give unto my son John Folk one hundred Acre of Land lying upon the waters of Little Garden adjoining Henry Spoonson & Adam Frown his wife on waggon Two horses & years one Cow & half for his only proper use & behoof forever

Fifthly As for the remainder of my children vizt Adam Folk An Mary Catharina Christian Chrysdalina Margaritha & Hannah Folk have received their portion equal to this my will so that is to have my lands before

I have made this my last will & Testament Sixthly I constitute make & ordain John Kraus & Jacob Spoonson sole Executors of this

my last will & Testament & I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannul all and every other former Testaments wills Legacies Bequests & Executors by me in any ways before named willed and bequeathed ratifying & confirming this and no other to be my last will & Testament in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Twenty third Day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred & Eighty Eight
