Krieger of Salem, States County & State of North Carolina
being weak in body, but of sound mind & memory
do this fourteenth day of July A.D. one thousand eight
& thirty four, make and publish this my last
will and Testament in manner & form following.
that is to say,

- 1) I will that all my just debts and my funeral
expenses by duly paid by my heiress named executor
- 2) I give & bequeath unto Daniel Miller of Endicott County
State of Maryland the sum of one hundred dollars &
to Elizabeth Ratty wife of Christian Ratty also
the sum of one hundred dollars.
- 3) I give & bequeath unto John Christian Becker of Salem
the sum of Fifty dollars also to John Jacob Blum
the sum of Fifty dollars.
- 4) I further give & bequeath unto Adrienne Rehler
as governs of the single sister chair in Salem
& to her successor or successors in office in trust
for the sum of One hundred dollars to the
sole & only use of the Salem single sister poor
fund.
- 5) I give & bequeath unto Sarah Spack of Salem
and to Anna Rothkeas of Salem & to Elizabeth Blum
wife of John P. Blum now in Indiana to each
and every one the sum of Thirty dollars.
- 6) I give & bequeath unto Justina Stockburger the
sum of Fifty dollars & further Ten dollars more in
addition.
- 7) I further give and bequeath unto John Krieger,
Jacob Krieger, Samuel Krieger, Daniel Krieger Junr,
Joseph Krieger, Henry Krieger & William Krieger all
of Maryland & to Henry Reischucker my nephew & to
Jacob Ratty & Maria Ratty daughter of Chas. Ratty &
to Barbara Wilkert to each and every one the sum
of Twenty five dollars.
- 8) I further give & bequeath unto Antoinette Smith daughter
of John Smith of Maryland, and to each of my grandchildren
viz. to Henrietta Moore wife of G. Moon of Maryland to Eliza
Krieger, Lisette Krieger Matilda Liverd Henrietta Rich
& Rebecca Ratty to each the sum of Twenty five dollars
and to my friends Barbara Lengenbach & Rebecca Hartman
to each the sum of Twenty five Dollars.

9. I give & bequeath unto my several friends to Mary White
 Adrienne Rieke, Barbara Holly widow, Charles Brainer
 Sally Materson, & Dorothy Blum wife of Jacob to each and
 every one the sum of Twenty Dollars.
- 10) I give & bequeath unto Adrienne Rehler the sum of Ten
Dollars, and to Hannah C. Shultz the sum of Five dollars.
- 11) I give & bequeath unto Elisabeth Stockburger my green silk
gown, and Matilda Liverd my chest of drawers, to Sophia
Maria Blum my desk & book case, to Justina Elisa Blum my
large bagueth brown silk frock & my black & my black
silk Mantle, & further I give to Adrienne Elizabeth Stockburger
the sum of Twenty Dollars.
- 12) My eighth, large looking glass I give to Elizabeth Ninkler
and to Henry Ninkler & William Ninkler to each I give three
of my Windsor chairs.
- 13) I will & bequeath unto Constantine Kortit my silver watch.
- 14) It is my will that all my remaining wearing apparel & clothes,
Linens, cottons, woolens & whatever not herein otherwise bequeathed
& all the remainder of my loose property shall be distributed
by my hereafter named Executor with the assistance & advice
of the governors of the Single Sister house in Salem amongst
the several Single Sister in the town of Salem, as near to a list
by me handed to them, and agreeable to their best judgment.
- 15) It is further my will that if any of my monies, or notes & bonds,
after all before mentioned expenses are paid & my funeral expense
& burial agreeable to use & custom in the church where I am
a member and all other expenses by my Executor incurred be
paid, then such balance of my estate shall be & I hereby
give it unto my nephew David Miller Senior.
- 16) I do hereby make & appoint my friend John Jacob Blum of
Salem my executor of this my last will & testament to the
same executed to & according to this my intent and meaning.
- In witness whereof I the wife Anne Margarett Krieger
here to this my last will & testament, set my hand and
seal the day & year first above written,
Signed sealed & declared as the last will & testament of Anne
Marg. Krieger in presence of
John C. Blum
Isaac Boner

Having for various reasons concluded to amend my last
will & testament, I do hereby make a codicil to the same
and make the following alterations, to wit, in Legacy & articulation
second items, so to read, and to Mary Abby daughter of Chas.
& Christian Ratty One hundred dollars instead of Elizabeth

103 Rudy wife of Christian Rudy. Further in article three
the legacy to John Christian Becker is void & annulled.
Also the article four legacy to Fratrica Becker interest
is void & annulled.

Also in article eight, the legacy of twenty five dollars
to Rebecca Hartman to be void and in her place bequeath
to Elizabeth Harbat widow of Henry R. Herbet the sum
of twenty five dollars.

Also in article nine legacy to Mary White is void & annulled.
In article ten I smoke & make void the legacy of ^{ten} dollars
to Fratrica Becker.

being of sound mind make this my last will and
testament. First that my soul may go to god when I
leave this world then all my just debts be paid
then after that my sons Daniel & Heath, and
Ike and John and Mary and Lavinia & Anna &
William & Lewis & Elizabeth and Sarah & her one
dollar ea. each then the widow to have eighty two &
acres of the south end of the old Plantation that I now
own, during her cooldhood or lifetime and the
widow to have all the money and debts on hand then
the balance of the tract to be sold after the widow
dies with this land and other property all take
