her death or marriage aforesaid to be equally divided between  
my two children as aforesaid to wit Samuel & Mary.

And I hereby appoint my wife Polly sole Executor of this  
my last will & testament in witness whereof I have hereunto  
set my hand & seal the 2nd day of August in the year of our Lord  
one thousand eight hundred & thirty three
