Carolina one bedstead, two chairs & two pillows my best underbed three feather pillows with cases, one cover bed with three cases, my best blanket, one white quilt, one home made spread, half of my shute which I have in use, one bureau, one old cloth cloak, one cut glass tumbler with gilt edge, one glass goblet, one german hymn book, one silk pocket handkerchief, one picture of Nazareth Church & one hundred dollars in money which one hundred dollars I direct my Executor to put on interest with good security & the interest accruing thereon to add to the principal during the minority of said Eugene Cluwell, at the expiration of which time both principal & interest are to be paid over to said Eugene Cluwell or his order,

Item II I give & bequeath unto Annette Cluwell, daughter of David Cluwell of Salem Stokes County N. Carolina, my best marine cloth cloak half of my shute which I have in use, my quilted petticoat one calicoe bed spread, one inferior bed quilt, my cotton shifts, my shorts night gown, three night caps, my linen stockings & my smaller cotton stockings, my best chair, one brookcase & Fifty dollar in money, which Fifty dollars I direct my Executor to put on interest with good security & the interest accruing thereon to add to the principal during minority of said Annette Cluwell at the expiration of which time both principal & interest are to be paid over to said Annette Cluwell or her order

Item III I give & bequeath unto David Cluwell of Salem Stokes County N. Carolina his note of twenty five dollars together with the interest due thereon at the time of my decease

Item IV I give & bequeath unto Dorothea Cluwell wife of David Cluwell of Salem Stokes County N. Carolina one wood

Item VII I give & bequeath unto Rebecca Stauber of Salem the sum of ten dollars; & unto the sick nurse of Salem Sisters house the sum of ten dollars.

Item VIII I give & bequeath unto the Treasures of the Bible Association of Salem Stokes County N. Carolina, the sum of ten dollars, for the use & benefit of said Association.

Item IX I give & bequeath unto the Treasures of the Home Mission Society of Salem, Stokes County N. Carolina the sum of ten dollars, for the use & benefit of said Society.

Item X It is my will & desire & I direct my executor to pay all the residue of my money, should there be any to the Salem Sisters Home poor Fund, for the use & benefit of said Fund.

Item XI I give & bequeath unto Catharine Schaffner, wife of John Schaffner of Salem, Stokes County N. Carolina my linen shifts, my largest pair of cotton stockings, my new coarse cotton shirt or the muslin for the same, two calicoe dresses, three night caps & two linen gowns.

Item XII I give & bequeath unto my sister-in-law Susan Linnbach, wife of my brother Joseph Linnbach, one large marine shawl, & unto the three daughters of my brother Joseph Linnbach, each one long white night gown.

Item XIII I give & bequeath unto my niece Sarah Fetter, wife of Peter Fetter of Salem Stokes County N. Carolina one good calicoe or gingham dress; unto my niece Maria Hall, wife of John Hall of Stokes County, one good calicoe or gingham dress; unto my niece Caroline Goff, wife of William Goff, of Stokes County, one good calicoe or gingham dress & one large net shawl.

Item XIV I give & bequeath unto my step sister Elizabeth Hansen wife of Solomon Hansen asst. of Botetourt Stokes County N. Carolina, one gray & black flowered woollen handkerchief.

Item XV I give & bequeath unto Henrietta Brunner, wife of Henry Brunner of Nazareth, Northampton County Pennsylvania one silver tupper spoon; & unto Louisa Albright, wife of Henry Albright of Nazareth, Northampton County Pennsylvania one silver teaspoon.
