I Isaac South of Doby County and State of North Carolina being very sick and weak but of perfect mind and memory (thanks be to God) to this twentieth day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three make and publish this my last will and Testament in manner following (that is to say)
First and foremost I have and bequeath to my son George South the plantation which is a large white and mine South I have an acre and a half with my home plantation and the King South and a large South the plantation where their father formerly lived and I further have and bequeath to my son George and Benjamin my whole interest share to the mills which are in partnership between myself and the King of Joseph Blake &c. also all the remaining part of land belonging to me with the homestead that they pay my daughter Elizabeth South the sum of three hundred dollars or otherwise to have an eye as there is the land and I have and bequeath to my daughter Elizabeth South all my black furniture and all my furniture clothing and all such other things as have been usually been looked upon by my family as his portion and to a my wife and her heirs the remaining part of my estate shall be sold by my executor and a sum shall be paid to the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars together with all my debts and in case of my death

99 to my estate to be distributed of following first my daughter Elizabeth to have three hundred and ten dollars of above mentioned and the remaining if any should be to be equally divided between my son George South and a Benjamin South and my daughter Elizabeth there is to say shall have alike among them all and I have and bequeath with Margaret South the sum of ten dollars of my estate and I have bequeath and appoin of my son George South and a Benjamin South my beloved son George South and a Benjamin South executor of this my last will and Testament and I make and bequeath all former wills and Testaments in writing the contrary to which I have set my hand and seal the day and date above written
