An Inventory of the Estate of Volition
Fry Senior Decd of which the foregoing is
true copy as returned by the Executor
& ordered to be entered which is done

In the name of God amen: I Britain ^{Copy}
of Stokes County State of N Carolina being very
sick in body but of good perfect mind among
& understanding, I not knowing the appointed hour
when to die do make hereunto make & ordain
this my last will and Testament. that is to
say first. I give and recommend my soul into
the hands of God that give it and my
body to the earth to be buried at the
direction of my Executors not doubting but to
have a happy resurrection and on touching
my worldly Estate I give bequeath & dispose
of the same in manner & terms as following
First it is my will that my last debts &
funeral expenses be be duly paid out of my Estate
by my Executors hereafter mentioned as also
all my outstanding debts due to me to be
satisfied by them

And then I give to my beloved wife during
all the plantation whereon I know live &
have held furniture & land plantation & hold
the home I have in my opinion know and
further except two four Negroes & the follow-
ing Negroes but Phannar and Mitty during her
widowhood and the increase of said Negroes to

be equally divided amongst his children
by his living wife Lucy and if my
Lucy should remain a widow she shall
have the said plantation & property
in her possession till my youngest child
comes of age and then Negroes with
the increase shall be equally divided
divided amongst my children Maria
Holly Charles Hatty and Rebecca and the
plantation to be sold and equally divided
amongst all my children

I will to my children by my first wife
the following Negro to my son George the
the negro girl Aggy to my son William the
negro boy Dick to my daughter Mary Anne
to my daughter Hatty, Lucy, to my son
John the negro boy Adam. Abraham to
my daughter Elizabeth and I also will to
my daughter Mary and Hatty shall have
each of them one far half. Or I expect
that my beloved wife Lucy is with child
and if the child should live I will that
it should share equal with the rest of
my children by my said wife Lucy
I have with nominate Executors and officers
my friends George Harris Esq. &

Hayton and no other to be my executors
of this my last will and Testament
I have made and I hereby revoke all other
former promises bequests legacies or by me
made and hereunto ratify and confirm this
