 Fry Senr. Decd of which the following is

In the name of God amen: I Britain <sup>County</sup>  
 of Stokes County State of N Carolina being very  
 sick in body but of good perfect mind among  
 & unassisted, & not knowing the appointed hour  
 when to die do make herewith make & ordain  
 this my last will and Testament. that is to  
 say first. I give and recommend my soul into  
 the hands of God that give it and my  
 body to the earth to be buried at the  
 direction of my Executors not doubting but to  
 have a happy resurrection and on touching  
 my worldly Estate I give bequeath & dispose  
 of the same in manner & terms as following  
 First it is my will that my last debts &  
 funeral expenses to be duly paid out of my Estate  
 by my Executors hereafter mentioned as also  
 all my outstanding debts due to me to be  
 collected by them  
 And then I give to my beloved wife Mary  
 all the plantation whereon I now live &  
 Town lots furniture & other plantation to hold  
 the term I have in of opinions know and  
 settle except two four Negroes & ship also the follow-  
 ing Negroes Sam Phlaaver and Milly during her  
 widowhood and the man of said Negroes to

be equally divided amongst his children  
 by his living wife Lucy and if my  
 Lucy should remain a widow she shall  
 have the said plantation & property in  
 her possession till my youngest child  
 come of age and then Negroes with  
 the increase shall be equally divided  
 divided amongst my children Maria  
 Polly Charles Hazy and Rebecca and the  
 plantation to be sold and equally divided  
 amongst all my children

I will to my children by my first wife  
 the following Negroes to my son George the  
 the negro girl Aggy to my son Daniel the  
 negro boy Dick to my daughter Nancy French  
 to my daughter Hazy, Lucy, to my son  
 John the negro boy Adam. Abraham to  
 my daughter Elizabeth and I also will to  
 my daughter Nancy and Hazy shall have  
 each of them one cow & half. In despite  
 that my beloved wife Lucy is with child  
 and if the child should live I will that  
 it should share equal with the rest of  
 my children by my said wife Lucy  
 I have with nominate Legatists and officers  
 my friends George Haven Esq: &

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 Mayton and no other to be my executor  
 of this my last will and Testament  
 I have seen and I hereby revoke all other  
 former promises bequests bequeaths or by me  
 made and hereunto ratify and confirm this  
 to be my last will & Testament
