to almighty God calling into mind the
Mortality of men & the destination of all
men come to die do make and ordain
this my last Will & Testament viz
(1st) all my worldly Estate shall after my
death be the sole and entire property of my
dear Wife Mary Christman to have and to
hold the same during her Widowhood &
if she should marry again, they shall have
the whole part of the whole estate as her own
sole property forever.

North Carolina being weak in body but of sound
and perfect mind & memory do make and ratify
this my last Will & Testament that is to say

First I will that all my personal Estate shall be
sold as soon after my decease as may be by my
Executors hereinafter named except such as are herein
after Willed and given to my dear Wife and that
all my lawful debts shall be paid.

Further Whereas my dear & loved Wife Ann, late the
Wife of Abraham Humbach De^d was by the said
Abraham Humbach appointed an Executrix of his last
Will & Testament and had also been put in possession
of land and plantations of the said Abraham Humbach
De^d I will that after my Decease my said wife Ann
shall be put in full and entire and sole possession of
all the rights gifts privileges & immunities given her
in the said last Will & Testament of her former Husband
the said Abraham Humbach De^d and shall have
the same as full free & entire as she she now had been
married to me

I further give and bequeath to my said dear Wife Ann
two fowls such as she shall choose all the bedding
and her paraphernalia, all my growing corn
except what is in my Ten Acres fields, and all the wheels
for which I have ^{been} this summer bargained and paid
for in Cash.
