this my last Will & Testament that is to say

First I will that all my personal Estate shall be
sold as soon after my decease as may be by my
Executors hereinafter named except such as are herein
after Willed and given to my dear Wife and that
all my lawful debts shall be paid.

Further Whereas my dear & loved Wife Ann, late the
Wife of Abraham Senbark Du? was by the said
Abraham Senbark appointed an Executor of his last
Will & Testament and had also been put in possession
of land and plantations of the said Abraham Senbark
Du? I will that after my Decease my said wife Ann
shall be put in full and entire and sole possession of
all the rights gifts privileges & immunities given her
in the said last Will & Testament of her former Husband
the said Abraham Senbark Du? and shall have
the same as full free & entire as she then had been
married to me

I further give and bequeath to my said dear Wife Ann
two fowls such as she shall choose all the bedding

for in Cash

I give and bequeath unto my Daughter
 Sally Wife of Joseph Chittler jun^r the sum
 of Eight pounds and to my Daughter
 Catherine I give & bequeath the sum of Ten
 pounds, my other children having had
 during my lifetime the full equivalent
 my real Estate shall be sold by my executor
 at public sale either for cash or on terms
 as they shall see fit and most advantageous
 and I do hereby authorize and empower my
 Executors or the survivor of them to grant
 convey and open said real Estate to the
 purchaser or purchasers by such conveyances
 as may be necessary for the better confirming
 the same to them or any of them And all
 monies arising therefrom and from the sale of
 my personal Estate shall be equally divided
 between my aforesaid wife beloved wife Ann
 and my children John, Peter, Charles, Margaret
 Sally wife of Joseph Chittler jun^r and Catherine
 share and share alike, making seven
 shares, And I do hereby constitute and
 appoint my said son Peter Smith and
 my son in law Joseph Chittler jun^r
 Executors of this my last Will and
 Testament. Fully revoking all former
