Know all men by these presents that I Joseph Ladd of the County & State above said for & in Consideration of the sum of fifty pounds hard Money to me in hand paid at & before the sealing & delivery of these presents by ^{all the parties who at the time of the sealing of these presents had knowledge of the contents of the same} S. Myr. Fearling & of all right title & claim I do hereby convey unto the said S. Myr. Fearling of Salem a certain Negro Woman named Dorothee about twenty six years old, to have and to hold the aforesaid Negro Woman unto the said S. Myr. Fearling his heirs Executors or Assigns forever and I the said Joseph Ladd for my self my heirs Executors or Administrators the said Negro Woman to the said S. Myr. Fearling his Executors &c. against me the said Joseph Ladd my Executors Administrators &c. Affirming & against all & every other person or persons whatsoever making any Lawfull Claim either by deed of gift or otherwise shall & will warrant & forever defend by these presents In Witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & seal hereunto this 30th day of April 1796

Know all men by these presents that I Christian Weaver of the County of Stokes and State of North Carolina for and in consideration of the sum of Fifty five Dollars Money of the United States to me in hand paid by Abraham Steiner of Blithsburg in the County, and State aforesaid have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell in open Market (and according to Law unto the said Abraham Steiner one Somer Mare about six years old about fourteen hands high branded on the near side with Daniel Steiner's legs, also one somer mare full one year old not branded, one Red and white pied cow, marked in the right ear with a smooth Crop, one red and white Huffer marked in the right ear with a smooth Crop one other Red and white pied cow marked in the right ear with a smooth Crop, and one black and white cow marked with a hole through one of her ears and a slit in the other. to the sole use and behoof of him the said Abraham Steiner his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Christian Weaver do by these presents put the said Abraham Steiner into full possession of the said Cattle with power to remove them at any and every time he pleases, and I will warrant, and defend the above Cattle and every part thereof to him the said Abraham Steiner his heirs and assigns forever against all claiming whatsoever of any person.
