

In the name of God Amen I Christopher Vogler of Salem
Salem County state of North Carolina being weak in body but of
sound mind & memory and calling to mind the uncertainty of
my life do make this my last Will and Testament in the
following manner that is to say

1 I give & bequeath unto my eldest son Gottlieb the tract of
land wherein he now resides containing eighty four acres
lying on the south fork of Middle Creek in said County which
I purchased of Abram Ziegler to be his sole property & his
hers forever further I give him & bequeath to him the sum
of two hundred and ninety seven dollars for which he has
given me his bond except the sum of one hundred & thirty for
which he has given no bond which sum is included in the above
sum further my executors is to pay him one hundred dollars in
cash & it is my desire & will that my executors shall cause to
erect a small dwelling house for his use on the above mentioned
land not exceeding in cost one hundred dollars to be paid out
of my estate this is all which I will to my son Gottlieb
& his heirs for ever

2 I give & bequeath to my son Nathaniel my house where
I now reside with my family together with all the
improvements (except the new Smith Shop & some of my
tools herein mentioned) the rest of all my tools not left
to Timothy all the fields adjoining to the mill with this
provision that Nathaniel shall be bound to allow
Timothy the use of said mill when he said Nathaniel
does not use it said Timothy bearing his share of the
recovery repairing said Nathaniel is to pay fair hundred
dollars to my executors for the benefit of my estate said
hundred being of so much more value as his share
allotted for him by me & further that he hold said
hundred lands under the same lease as I have heretofore
to be his share of my estate as his property for himself
& his heirs for ever

3 My son Timothy I give and bequeath the sum of one
thousand dollars & the new Smith Shop the large

bush Wife small arrears & bellows & all the gun stocks
flea & two small hand Nipes to stone ledge two hand
hammers & one pair of tongs & all the coal or hard to be
his property for ever

4 To my son in law Christian Hoge I have advanced in
my life time at different times eleven hundred dollars of said
sum I give and bequeath him for ever one thousand dollars
& to my said son in law shall pay to my executors the
sum of one hundred dollars for the use of my estate &
my executors shall give up to the said Hoge all the paper
I have against him

5 To my daughter Polina I give & bequeath the sum
of one thousand dollars as her property for ever to
be put on interest by my executors or her guardians
until she arrives at full age

6 To my youngest daughter Reginald I give and bequeath
the sum of one thousand dollars the interest of the said
sum is to be paid to my wife as long as my sd
daughter goes to school & after she leaves the school the
interest on for my said daughter benefit to be her & her
heirs for ever

7 Now I am at present engaged in building a house
for my self which is not finished if it should please
God to call me away before it is finished I lay in
on my executors to have said building neatly finished
likewise three out houses & fence & garden & a well
in the yard said expenses for said building to be paid out
of my estate said house I give & bequeath to my
beloved wife during her natural life - further I will
that my wife shall have of my house & kitchen furniture
what ever they choose likewise my house clock cash & stock
one sixteen shaper corner cupboard or other furniture which
she may want further two cows & food for them for one year
Sparks further provision for to maintain her & the children
that live with her for one year

all the rest and residue of my estate both real and personal
can to be sold by my executors either at private or publick sale
whence ever the consider the best advantage for my estate the money
arising from said sale & together with all the money I have due
me & the third share of Bank Stock I own are to interest there-
from after all my lawful debts are paid to be paid to my
dear beloved wife during her natural life and after
the decease of my said beloved wife the house bequeathed
to her during her natural life is to be sold by my executors
for the benefit of my heirs & the principal of the money left of
which she is to enjoy the interest during her natural life together
with the sum that arises from the sale of my said house &
after her decease to be equally divided amongst all my children
Gothlieb Nathaniel Timothy Anne Maria married to Christian Hege
Pauline, Regarding each of them to have share and those other
as their sole property for ever

8 further I appoint and ordain my trusty friend John Vogler
of Salem & my son in law Christian Hege Executory of this
my last will and testament who I trusty empower to sell
and convey my lands & make right & title to collect all
my debts & to pay & settle all my just debts &c. I do hereby make
void all former wills & testaments & legacies done by me either
in writing or by word of mouth confirming this to be my last
will and testament In witness whereof I have hereunto
set my hand & affixed my seal the seventh day of July one
thousand eight hundred & twenty seven
