I Daniel Christman of Robeson in the County of Stokes in the State of North Carolina (corpse) being weak in body but of sound mind & memory thank be given to Almighty God calling into mind the Mortality of Man & knowing it to be the destination of all men once to die. Do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament. This Principally & first of all I give my soul into the Hands of my dear Creator Jesus Christ who gave it & my body to be interred in a decent Christian Burial at the discretion of my Executors. And as touching such worldly Estate wherewith I am possessed in this world I give & bequeath this same in manner & form following —

1. I give & bequeath unto Johanna my dear & beloved wife all my remaining Estate to have and to hold the same as her own sole property so long as she shall live a Widow but in case she should marry again she shall have the third part thereof in her own sole property forever & then the other two thirds are to be divided equally amongst my seven children (names) Philippina, Christina, Anna, Sabina, Dorothea, Daniel & Jacob Shaw & their alikes.

2. And I do hereby make, ordain, constitute and appoint my beloved wife Johanna & my trusty friends John Lumbach & Alexander Reich, Executors of this my last Will & Testament & they are by me empowered to pay all my debts punctually and settle all accounts to the satisfaction of my Creditors. And I do hereby disannul & make void all former wills & legacies done by me either in writing or by word of mouth ratifying & confirming this & no other to be my last Will & Testament. In witness whereof I have hereunto put my hand & seal hereunto this 7th day of November 1799.

In the name of God amen. August the fifteenth in

the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and eighteen. I Israel Robinson of Stokes County and State of North Carolina being at this time low in body but of sound mind and memory do make and ordain this my last Will and Testament.

1st I will that all my just debts and funeral charges be paid out of my body and book accounts if sufficient if not I will that one hundred acres of my land be sold and such other of my property as my Executors may think best sufficient to satisfy all my just debts.

2nd I give and bequeath to my beloved wife Sarah the remaining part of my land ^{during} her life or widowhood for the purpose of raising & educating my children.

3rd I give and bequeath unto my beloved wife a negro girl named Sarah during her natural life together with all my personal Estate for the purpose of raising & educating my children as aforesaid.

4th I will that at my wife's death or marriage my land be equally divided between my three sons Jacob, Michael & Charles Robinson.

5th I will that at my wife's death the negro girl with all her increase be equally divided between my two Daughters Mary Ann & Elizabeth Robinson.

6th I will that after my wife's death all my personal estate not heretofore willed be sold and the proceeds be equally divided between all my children.

7th I do hereby nominate my beloved wife Sarah my executrix & my father Isaac Robinson & my father-in-law Michael Shaw my lawful Executors of this my last Will and Testament.
