of Stokes County and State of North Carolina being
in health of body and mind thanks be given
unto God calling unto mind the mortality of my
body and knowing that it is appointed for all men
once to die do make and ordain this my last will
& testament. As touching such mortal estate wherewith
it has pleased god to bless me with in this life I give
and dispose of the same in the following manner &
form. First that my wife beloved wife Mary have
one third of my moveable estate by her freely to
be enjoyed during her widow hood & also give to my
eldest son Joseph the sum of Ten pounds & my second son
Cleatow the sum of Ten pounds and my third son John
the sum of Twenty pounds my youngest son Doughty
one hundred acres of land to be taken of from the
south end of my Drivley plantation so as for it to
take in what is called the old orchard & Spring &c.
Now I have three Daughters living which I have
given their portions unto but to keep them in renum-
brance of me I give to each of them Five Dollars
a piece their names is Mary Sundy and Content
Wortman & Elizabeth Sundy also it is my will
that my Grand Daughter Mary Sundy should have
a feather bed and one cow and it is also my
will that my plantation should be sold and mortgaged
and all my Just Debts paid and after the wife
has rec'd her third the remaining two thirds

52 to be divided equally amongst the four sons
aforesaid Joseph Stockton & George Stockton
John Stockton & Doughty Stockton I also constitute
and ordain Joseph Mendenhall my wife's executor
and Executrix of this my last will & testament
and I do hereby utterly devolve revoke & renounce
all and every other former testament, wills, legacies,
bequests & executors by me in any ways before named
willed and bequeathed Ratifying & confirming this
and no other to be my last will & testament
I witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand

last will & testament in the following form & manner
viz.

I recommend my soul into the hands of Almighty God
my Creator & Saviour and my body I commit unto the
earth to be decently buried in a Christian Manner
and as touching such worldly estate wherewithal
it hath pleased God to bless me in this life I dispose
of in the following manner

First I do give & bequeath unto my eldest son
Jacob Two hundred & thirty five Dollars

Secondly I give and bequeath unto my son Joseph the
upper part of my land joining Benjamin Kelly's land
downwards to marked bushes then turning perches
west then Twenty perches South then partly a
south east course to Dolson's line And also a man
for thirty five Dollars land and man equal
to Two hundred & thirty five Dollars

Thirdly and unto my son George I give and bequeath
a tract of land beginning on a branch on John
Miller's line three east to Hickory on Creek line
Joining Jacob Miller's land containing one hundred
acres more or less also a man for Seventy Dollars
Land & man Two hundred & thirty Dollars & pay
thirty five Dollars thereof to the executors

Fourthly I give and bequeath unto my son Frederick
