I Edward Evans of the State of North Carolina and Stokes County being my self weak in body, but of cheerful mind & memory, thanks be given unto God, falling unto mind the mortality of my body & knowing that it is appointed for all men once to die, do make & ordain this my last Will & Testament as touching such and such Estate wherewith it has pleased God to bless me in this life, I give devise and dispose of the same in the following manner & form

First I give and bequeath to my loving wife Martha Evans all the residue of my worldly Estate after paying my just debts during her lifetime — and after her Decease for the tract of land whereon she now lives to be sold at public sale to the highest Bidders on twelve months credits and that money together with the all the perishable property to be equally divided between my eight children (viz) Margaret Mary Sarah Rebekah John Hampton Elizabeth and Rosanna Evans. Also a tract of land lying and being in the Western County which land I have Gray Bynum bound for a right for, of which I give & bequeath to my Brother John Evans one hundred acres and the remainder to be equally divided amongst my above named children

But if the said Gray Bynum was his best friend soon to get a right and never can obtain one it is in my wish that my heirs or Executors shall never sue said Bynum or his heirs for a right

Also I make and ordain John Evans Sen. and Charles Bannan Executors of this my last Will and Testament and I do hereby utterly disallow revoke and disannull all and every other former testaments Wills and Legacies bequests and Executors by me in any wise before named willed or bequeathed saying and performing this and no other to be my last Will and Testament In witness whereof I the said Edward Evans have hereunto set my hand and Seal this fifteenth Day of December in the year of our Lord One thousand seven hundred & ninety three

Edward Evans published pronounced and declared by the said Edward Evans his last will & Testament in the presence of us who in his presence and in the presence of each other have hereunto subscribed our names
