the Plantation wherow I now live to answer of as she
desireth to her own benefit & the Children as long
as the birth till her death to be held & equally divided
amongst all my Children except in leaving out my son
John & William which I now by give unto my said
son John & William who is called White Plains
which I count 120 acres to be equally divided between
in quantity & quality as soon as my son will and
comes of age still allowing my son John as soon as he
comes of age to have the whole or part of
said land till such time as my son William comes
of age & lastly I appoint & nominate my brother William Davis
& my wife Mary as executors to my estate.

I Elizabeth Brown of Nobles County
State of North Carolina being very weak infirm
in body but of perfect mind & sound memory
do the twenty-third day of May in the year
of our Lord one thousand eight hundred eleven
make and ordain this to be my last will
& testament in manner & form following

As my estate (or those upon whom proportion my
estate is) reside in Bohemia Manor State of Maryland
from which State I have been about upwards of
Thirty years. I deem it therefore necessary and expedient
here to give an account of my Pedigree in order
that my heirs may be enabled more easily to
convince them on whence he must call or in
other words those who may hold my estate of
the identity of my person & prevent disputes
from arising from that quarter.

83 My Pedigree as follows viz. I am Daughter to Michael Nide who had & died in Bohemia Manor about two miles from the Manor Church my father's Children were named as follows viz. the Eldest Joseph Nide Mary Nide Daniel Nide Catharine Nide John Nide Susanna Nide Nancy Nide Sarah Nide myself & my other Nides and Jacob Nide these are the names of my father's family. After the Death of my father my Mother married a certain Jacob Bier who at his decease bequeathed her a considerable estate which my Mother willed to my Sister Nancy Catharine & myself. My brother John Nide wrote to my Sisters to come & receive the said estate but I never went neither did I ever empower any Person to obtain it for me.

I was married in Bohemia Manor Cecil County & State of Maryland to Benjamin Elsbury son of Frederick Elsbury of the said County & State. After the decease of my said husband I removed to York County State of Pennsylvania where I was again married to Christian Brown with whom I removed to the State of North Carolina where I still remain.

Some years ago my said husband viz Christian Brown deserted me thus taken up with another woman & I was left without any person to take care of me in my full aged & infirm state in this forsaken forlorn & distressed situation I came to Jacob Miller of Stokes County State of North Carolina (my sister Nancy's son) whom I still remain said Jacob Miller together with his family have been & continue to be very tender of me and has showed me much kindness which has induced me to make this my last will & Testament as follows Part I give and bequeath unto Jacob Miller of Stokes County State of North Carolina (my sister Nancy's son) all my estate in the State of Maryland or elsewhere to him this being done. & I do hereby constitute nominate & appoint him the said Jacob Miller executor of this my last will & Testament & I do hereby utterly renounce disannul & make void all former wills & Testaments by me at any time hereof made ratifying & confirming & establishing this the other to be

my last will & Testament
