In the name of Good Amen! the twelve day of March  
1818 I Elizabeth Lidy widow of Michael Lidy A.D. of Stots County  
that Carolina being my next in age has perfect mind &  
memory that he give unto her therefore calling to mind the  
mortality of my body (knowing) that it is appointed for all flesh  
to die we make and ordain this my last Will and Testament  
that is to say principally & first of all I give & recommend my soul  
into the hands of the Almighty God that gave it very long to the  
world to be buried in a Christian burial at the direction of  
my executors nothing dethying but at the general resurrection

also my son Philip one dollar and my son Michael Lidy  
and his wife each fifty cents and my son James Lidy one  
dollar each of my daughters that to say my daughter  
Margaret wife of Sacot Miller one dollar Anna Lidy  
wife of Christian Lusk one dollar Elizina Phillips wife of  
Samuel Phillips one dollar unto my daughter Lucy widow  
of James Hays and fifty dollars to have & to hold forever

(M.) I do hereby appoint my son John Lidy my executor  
of this my last Will & Testament & I do hereby entirely  
disannul revoke & make void all former wills by me  
herefore made Relifying & confirming this & no other  
to be my last Will & Testament
