all my property that is not by this will otherwise disposed  
of be sold by my executor on a credit of nine or twelve  
months and the money arising from the same be equally  
divided between my nine heirs Enoch, Mary, Abby,  
Primer, Robert, Elender, Elizabeth, Smith and  
William. I do hereby constitute and appoint my true  
friend Aaron Linville my lawful executor to all  
events and purposes to execute this my last will and  
testament according to the true intent and meaning  
of the same and every part and every clause thereof  
hereby revoking and declaring utterly void all other  
wills and testaments by me before now made. In witness  
whereof I the said Robert Hutchins do herunto set  
my hand & seal this 16 day of November 1843.
