as long as she lives and then the said estate  
be equally divided amongst my children  
and my house is to be sold and the money  
equally divided to my children Jacob  
Henry Mary Magdalene Catherine Elizabeth  
& Louisa and I do constitute witness  
and sign same Thomas and Henry

and Henry Holbreke executors of this my last  
will and Testament and I do hereby atting  
swear and make all former Testaments  
Wills Agrees and executors ratifying foregoing  
this and no other to be my last will &  
Testament in Writing whereof I have countersigned  
at my home and seal this ninth day  
of August in the year of our Lord one  
thousand seven hundred and Ninety nine
