in mind and memory do constitute make and ordain
this my last will and testament Principally and first
I wish all my stock of every description sold to
pay my just debts except my note of one
I will my black walnut chest to my daughter Mary
and also one low Bedstead, two wheels, one reel, and
loom and also my negro girl Fanny & her man.
I will to my son Gabriel my maple curtain bedstead, one
bureau, and smallest folding leaf table my cart, and
axes and one half of farming tools.
I will to my son Samuel & my walnut curtain bedstead
large folding leaf table, Blue carpet, and blue cushions
and the other half of the farming tools and a negro
boy name Peter.
I will that all the property both real and personal that
I may have from my father's estate to be equally divided
between my three children Mary, Gabriel & Samuel &
and I also will that all my Dress & bed clothing shall
be equally divided between them I will that my son
Gabriel and daughter Mary & son Samuel & shall be
made equal in their parts of my property and I will

that all the property and money that may be found
at my death not named in the will to be equally divided
between the three children - I further moreover will that if
son Samuel & stands to the swap of negro I made
with Ruthenia Cize & her child for a negro girl named
Martha Ruthenia Blackburn given me four hundred dollars
to boot to have of my property as the will direct above
but if he does not I will that he shall receive no
part of my property whatever I constitute nominate
& appoint my truly friend John R. Hampton of
Town Fork and of Stokes County as executor to this
my last will & testament made this 9. th. of April
1835 Signed in the presence of the subscribing witnesses

Cow and one yearling her choice out of my flock, also three sheep
her choice the further Red Bedstead and furniture one chest
one Ring wheel one pot one Doorn six plates one looking glass one
pair of Cards her choice which articles will make an equal
portion with the rest of my Children out of my estate to be

hers and at her Disposal forever. Fourthly I give and Devise
to my beloved wife Ruth all the remainder of my property
of every kind to be hers so long as she lives and after her Death
to belong to my son George Clampt and his heirs forever
provided he attends to and maintains his mother from my Death
until her Death. Fifthly and lastly I do hereby constitute and
appoint my trusty friend George Clampt my lawful Executor
to all intents and purposes to Execute this my last will and
testament according to the true intent and meaning of the
same and every part thereof hereby making and making
utterly void all other wills and testaments by me heretofore
made in writings whereof I the said William Clampt do here
unto set my hand and seal this 18th day of July 1839.
